

- 1. Hiset
 - Will be a hybrid virtual and face to face
 - The HiSET exam measures the academic knowledge and proficiency equivalent to those of a high school graduate. It covers five content areas:
 - Language Arts Reading
 - Language Arts Writing
 - Mathematics
 - Social Studies
 - Science
- 2. JAG Responsible Citizens and productive co-worker; drop out prevention/recovery
