- 2016 pop. est. 11,114
- No industry
- Median income \$ 31,926
- 23.8 % of population live below poverty level
- School Board is the largest employer

 - The Catahoula Parish School system participates in the CEP program.



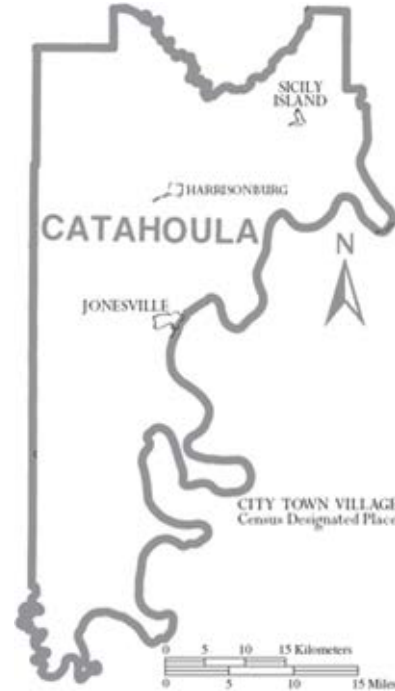
High Schools in West Carroll

 - Harrisonburg
 - Central (Larto)
- 1 – 8-12 school
 - Block (Jonesville)
- 50 mile difference between the north and the south



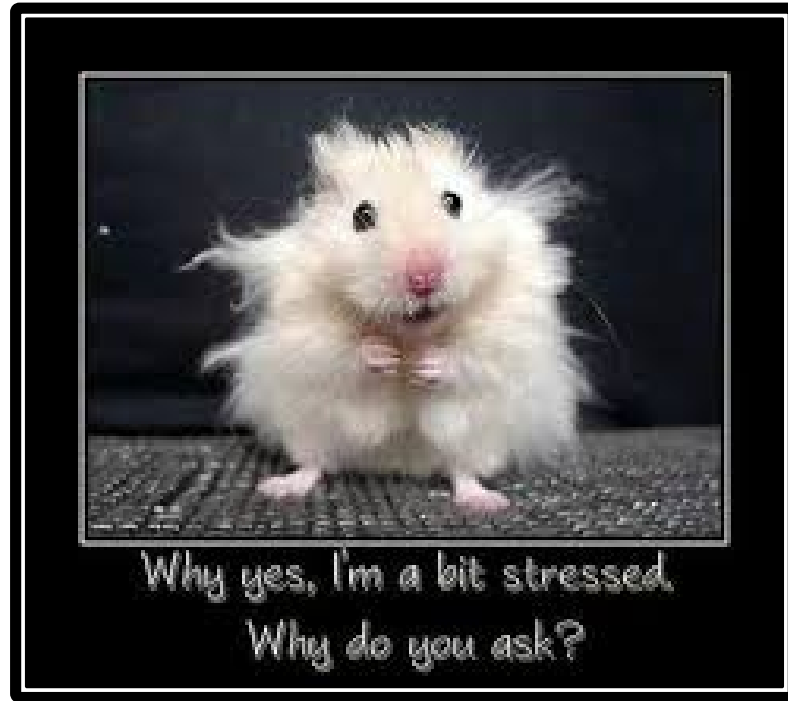

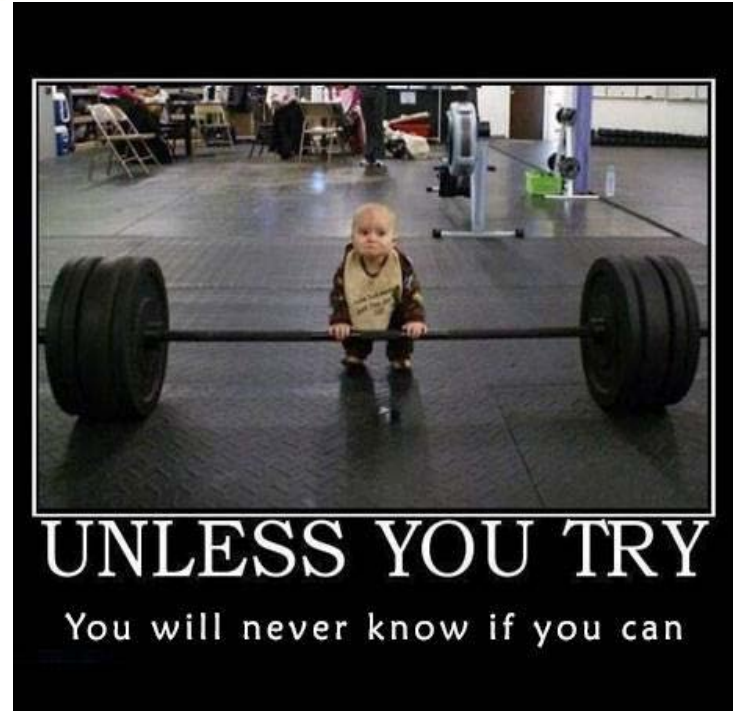

Planning Process - 3

- Look at the possibilities of where to offer credentials.
- Core Credential: FEMA IS-700a
 - Civics to all 9th graders regardless of Diploma Pathway
- Complementary Credentials:
 - Customer Service
 - Because of age requirements of test, stand-alone course in grade 11 to all students
 - Microsoft Word/PowerPoint/Excel
 - IBCA, BCA, Word Processing in grades 10-11

Planning Process - 5

Time to “convince” principals that pathways are needed at their schools.

- Jump Start is included as an agenda item at each Principals’ Meeting
- Modified packets were given for chosen pathways at each high school
- Work done ahead of time...no additional work put on them!

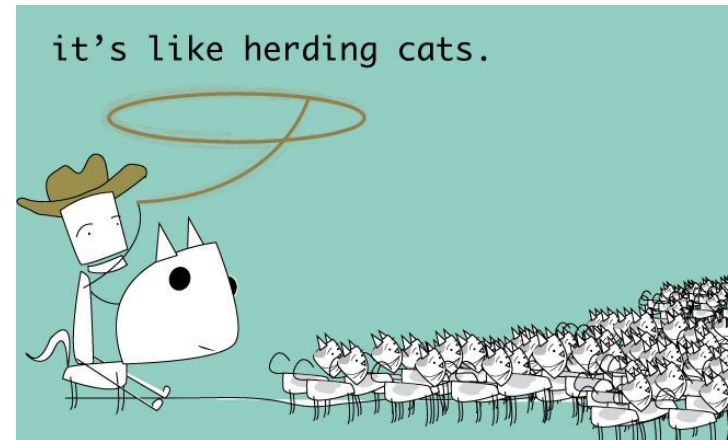

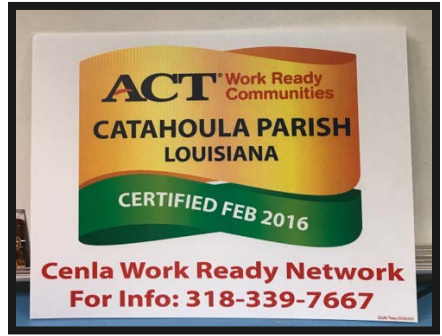
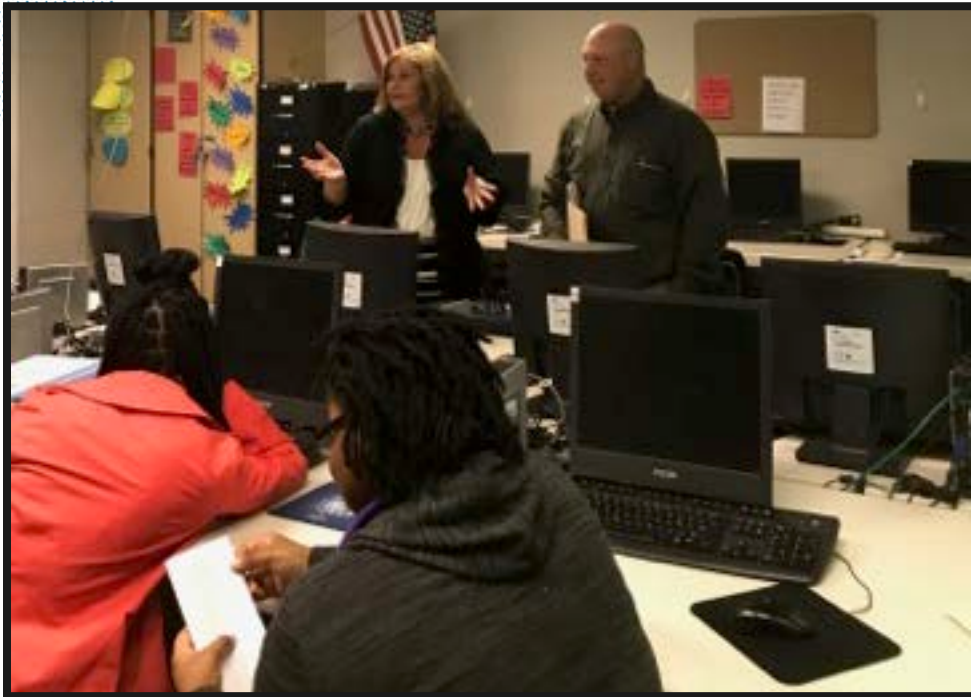




Jumpstart Summer Program in West Carroll

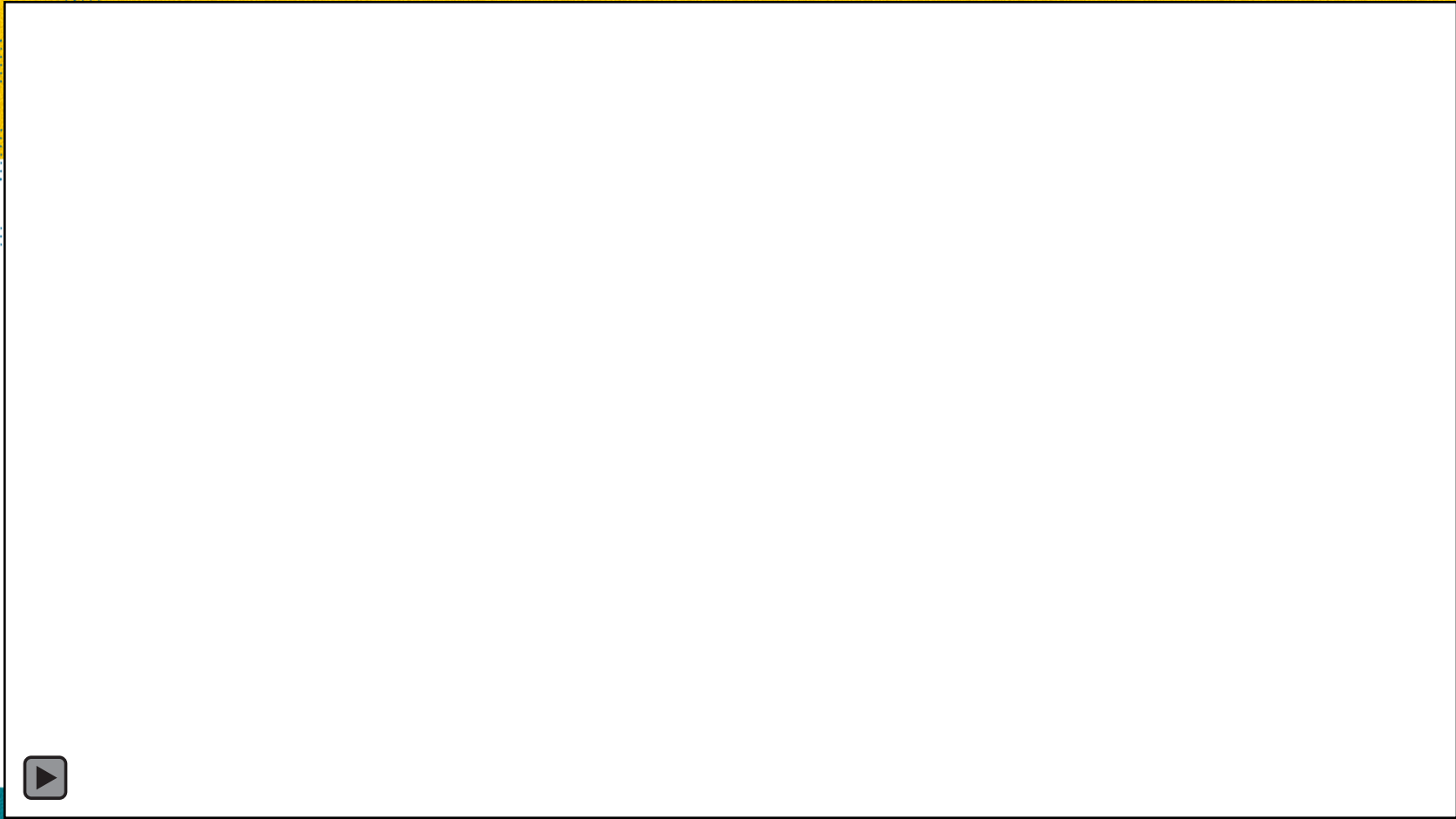


Jumpstart Summer Program in Catahoula
