### WHAT IS AN IBC?

An Industry-Based Certification (IBC) is an industry-accepted third-party credential verifying a student's skills and knowledge according to industry



# WHAT IS THE INDUSTRY-BASED CERTIFICATION (IBC) COUNCIL?

- A subcommittee of the Workforce Investment Council
- Responsible for evaluating the alignment of credentials with state workforce demand
- Members represent Industry, Government, Higher Education, K-12 Education, and Skilled Apprenticeship

Workforce Investment Council (WIC)

Occupational Forecasting Conference (OFC)

Industry-Based Certification Council (IBCC)

#### **CERTIFICATION APPLICATION PROCESS**

#### **Application Submission**

Requesting entity submits a completed application and all supporting documentation to Director of the Louisiana Workforce Investment Council (WIC)



#### Initial Information Review

WIC staff and IBC Council Chairman reviews application for completeness and ensures it meets key criteria



#### **IBC Council Review**

IBC Council reviews information provided to determine if there is substantial evidence to support the inclusion of a new IBC to the State Focus List



#### Final Approval by WIC

Upon IBC Council approval, the application is added to the agenda for a subsequent WIC meeting

## KEY CRITERIA FOR IBC APPROVAL

Monitored and updated according to industry changes; requires periodic re-certification

Should not be vendor-specific, unless specially approved by the IBC Council




## **IBC** Bundles

- A Basic Bundle is a set of stackable credentials, where each earned credential
  adds value to a student's qualifications enhancing their competitiveness on
  the market.
  - While individual credentials may have limited value to employers, the bundle objectively demonstrates to employers that a student possesses a highly valued set of technical skills
- Process to approve bundles mirrors approval process for single IBCs:
  - Submit application to WIC
  - Application is reviewed by WIC staff
  - Approval by IBC Council
  - Approval by WIC

## REMEMBER

- Must Fit the Definition of an Industry-Based Certification (IBC)
- Must Support Employment in High-Demand & High-Wage Occupations
- Must have State, National, or International Recognition
- Must be Backed by Louisiana Employers
- Must be Approved by the IBC Council and WIC to be on the State Focus List
- Explain the Workforce Demand on the IBC Application
