

## Overview

Accountability codes are an important component of state testing. The codes are used when students do not use pre-identified test materials for LEAP, iLEAP, EOC, ACT, LAA 1 (all grades) and LAA 2 (grades 3-8). Scores of zero are assigned to unused pre-identified tests unless appropriate accountability codes are applied to them.

Accountability codes are applied directly to answer documents for LEAP, *i*LEAP, LAA 1 and LAA 2. For EOC and ACT tests, accountability codes are entered into the EOC online system.

## **Applying Accountability Codes**

Accountability codes should be applied to tests for students who:

- Are no longer enrolled in school
  - o The code should match the exit code used in SIS.
- Experience a medical emergency that prevents them from testing
  - o A doctor's letter is required which includes all dates of testing, including make-up dates.
- Are pre-identified to take tests that are not appropriate based on the student's grade level, IEP, graduation requirements, or course enrollment.
  - o There should be documentation in SIS, SER, or STS to support the code.
- Are limited English proficient and in attendance at a U.S. school for less than one year.
  - o Students meeting these criteria must still take the test; however, the score will not be used.
