Round Robin Update

The table below shows the current status of the round robin cycles for each grade. Note the round robin grades that have fewer than 10 school choices remaining (highlighted yellow). The round robin will be reset in these grades when there are only 4 school choices remaining and all non-exempt schools will re-open a round robin seat. Schools have the option of submitting an exemption request for future round robin cycles. Please refer to previous enrollment communication for more information on the exemption request process.

Round Robin Exemptions

While all schools should be prepared to accept mid-year students, we understand that schools may be over-enrolled in some grades. The attached document provides information on submitting a request to be exempt from a Round Robin cycle, and details the standards used to assess those requests. All exemption requests must be submitted at least one business day in advance of the Round Robin reset. Matching to 10/1 Seat Availability

Schools with at least 2 seats available in any grade can elect to match to their 10/1 target when Round Robin begins. This option allows schools that would still like to increase their enrollment to take more than 1 student per cycle in the Round Robin process. Please complete this form if you would like to match to seat availability in any grades. Schools matching to seat availability will continue as a regular Round Robin participant if they reach their 10/1 target. You can submit a reguest to match to 10/1 Seat Availability here.

Re-Entry Policy Addendum

It has come to our attention that the re-entry policy was miscommunicated in last week's newsletter. Please note that students who are re-entering the public school system from secure care are guaranteed a spot at their last school of record for up to 60 *calendar* days, not school days. Please note that the Main Round application dates have now been posted to EnrollNOLA.org. Please ensure students and families seeking to submit an application are aware of this resource. As the launch of this year's application approaches, more information will be made available on our website to applying families. We appreciate your support in ensuring families have access to this information.

IMPORTANT REMINDERS

Post 10/1 Hardship Transfers

As of October 2, students must demonstrate a verifiable safety, medical, or childcare hardship necessitating a change in school environment in order to change schools through the remainder of the school year. As always, the parent / guardian must fill out the form and initiate the request for a transfer. Requests will not be considered without proper documentation. If you have questions or concerns about how students qualify for a Hardship Transfer, or have difficultly locating this year's forms, please email enrollment.support@rsdla.net.

A few important reminders as you submit transfer requests:

- Do not allow students to withdraw from school until you receive official approval from the Office of Student Enrollment. Transfers are evaluated on a case-by-case basis, and are often denied. In the event that a transfer is denied, the student will continue to attend your school. It is the responsibility of the sending school to ensure that students are not truant while transfer requests undergo the review process.
- Please do not submit transfer requests on outdated forms. New forms were shared in last week's newsletter, and are also now available on the School Resources webpage
 referenced above.
- Valid safety transfers are submitted by a family in reference to concerns for the safety of the student. We will not consider safety transfers allegedly recommended for the safety of faculty or staff.
