

Maintenance of Effort (MOE) Fiscal Requirements

Please forward to Business Managers and Financial Officials of Public School Districts Charter Schools, Lab Schools, and Other Entities and State Agencies defined as an LEA for these purposes.

Meeting yearly Maintenance of Effort (MOE) requirements are part of the business process to confirm compliance and determine eligibility of federal grant funds for ESSA (formerly NCLB) and IDEA grants. The USDE requires an annual review that determines if each LEA: 1.) has not decreased spending of general fund dollars, and 2.) is budgeting expenditures to meet the MOE standards. There are 3 MOE measurements submitted in the eGMS system.
