Scope of Work:

The specific responsibilities of Teacher Leader Advisors will vary depending on the content area and time of year but will include the following types of activities:

- Reviewing and evaluating the quality of curricula and instructional materials
- Providing input on and creating high-quality instructional resources
- Leading professional development sessions for fellow Louisiana educators
- Raising awareness among Louisiana educators of the tools and resources available in the Louisiana Teacher Toolbox

Becoming a Teacher Leader Advisor requires educators to commit to completing additional work and travel outside of their regular duties.

- Average five (5) hours per week (varies from week to week)
- Up to two (2) days of in-state travel for training

Applications are currently open for the following areas:

- Early Childhood Education Content Support and Instructional Materials Review
- Foundational Skills/Reading Intervention Instructional Materials Review
- K-12 ELA Content Support and ELA Instructional Materials Review
- K-12 Math Content Support and Math Instructional Materials Review
- K-12 Science Content Support and Science Instructional Materials Review

Who should apply?

There is a specific need for expert educators in the areas of **early literacy**, **intervention specialist**, and **K-12 science**. We also need **K-12 teachers across ELA and math** content areas. **Special education teachers** who specialize in these areas are also encouraged to apply.
