ART ENTRIES

- The entry must be an original work by the contestant that focuses on the current theme.
- All artwork must be in color using crayons, colored pencils, watercolors, acrylics, oils, etc.
- Artwork must be presented horizontally on paper or canvas.
- · Materials used must be non-edible.
- Artwork must be no larger than 11 inches high by 14 inches wide (28 cm x 35.5 cm).
- All work must be self-produced. Computer generated, computer enhanced, and photographic artwork will be disqualified.
- Artwork that has been submitted to other competitions is not eligible for this contest.
- Winning (awarded) entries are not eligible for other contests.
- Only one art entry per participant will be accepted; additional art entries will be disqualified.*
- Non-winning entries for this contest may be returned if a correctly-sized self-addressed envelope with proper postage is included with the entry. Winning entries will not be returned.
- The completed official entry form and release must be attached to the back of the entry by one paper clip or staple. Do not use glue or tape.
- The artist's and a parent or guardian's signature is required on the entry form.
- The participant's name is to be written on the back of the entry.
- The participant's name is not to be written on the front of the entry.
- · The entry should not be framed or matted.
- Entries that do not comply with all of the contest rules will be disqualified.

LANGUAGE ARTS ENTRIES

- The entry must be an original work written by the contestant that focuses on the current theme.
- The entry may be in story form, a reflection, creative narrative, work of poetry or any written form of the writer's choosing.
- The entry must be no more than 500 words.
- The entry must be typed or printed.
- Only one language arts entry per participant will be accepted; additional languages arts entries will be disqualified.
- Written work that has been submitted to other competitions is not eligible for this contest.
- Winning (awarded) entries are not eligible for other contests.
- Language arts entries submitted for this contest will not be returned.
- The completed official entry form and release must be attached to the back of the entry by one paper clip or staple. Do not use glue or tape.
- The writer's and a parent or guardian's signature is required on the entry form.
- The participant's name is to be written on the back of the entry.
- The participant's name is not to be written on the front of the entry.
- Multiple-page entries should be single stapled in the upper lefthand corner.
- The title of the entry must be included on the first page.
- Entries that do not comply with all of the contest rules will be disqualified.

All submissions must be postmarked by June 15.
Participants may submit one entry in each category.
However, should a participant place in both, the participant must choose which entry receives the award.
The participant cannot receive an award for both arts and language arts categories.
