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Avid Learning Partner Program Overview

Avid's Learning Partner (ALP) program is designed for independent training companies, corporations, universities or other educational institutions that provide training on Avid products. By combining the industry strength and instructional excellence of our partners with Avid's curriculum development and product expertise, we can ensure our customers achieve the highest level of success in their field.

The ALP program is designed to attract the most skilled training organizations in the industry. Our goal is to add visibility to the resources and capabilities of these strategically chosen partners to assist us in training our customers worldwide.

The foundation of the program is the Avid Official Course Books delivered by instructors who have been certified by Avid, in a qualified training environment.

Students successfully completing individual official Avid courses are entitled to an Avid Certificate of Completion. The Avid Certification Program further supports ALPs with course paths and exams for students to become Avid Certified.

Partner Types

There are two partner types available in the ALP program:

- **Academic**: Partners from universities or other educational institutions can add value to their programs by adding authorized instruction and certification.
- **Professional**: Partners from independent training companies or corporations can offer short-form training in their facilities.

Program Benefits

Program Requirements

ALPs are authorized by Avid after meeting Avid's requisites for quality and consistency, accomplished in part by using Avid Certified Instructors and Avid Official Course Books. A summary of Avid's ALP program requirements follows.

FACILITY REQUIREMENTS

An ALP facility requires the availability of at least one training room for the purpose of offering Avid Official Courses. Training room requirements will vary, depending on the type of training offered. Avid Training Partner Managers will provide guidance to partner candidates in assessing and equipping their facilities to meet the qualification requirements General requirements include:

- Avid-qualified computers and qualified media storage systems with a 1-1 student to system ratio.
- Each training room requires projection equipment.
- Avid requires ALPs to run the most updated version of Avid software and have the most upto-date Avid-dedicated hardware.
- o The center must equip its facility with all peripheral equipment related to specific courses.

CERTIFIED INSTRUCTOR REQUIREMENTS

All Avid Official courses must be taught by instructors who have successfully completed the Avid Certified Instructor (ACI) process. All ACI's must maintain their certifications by:

- o Keeping their certifications current for each course they have been certified to teach.
- o Maintaining a minimum quality metric on student evaluations.

ALP PROMOTIONAL REQUIREMENTS

ALPs will promote Avid's Official Curriculum by:

- Listing Avid courses in the Partner's brochures, website, schedules and elsewhere as appropriate.
- Supplying Avid a link on its web site to its course schedule and provide Avid with a quarterly training schedule of all Avid courses at least one month prior to the beginning of each calendar quarter.
- Avid standard course names and numbers must be used in all relevant advertising, and any non-Avid courses offered by Partner must be clearly differentiated from Avid courses.
- After successful completion of an Avid Official Course, ALPs shall provide students with Avid's Certificate of Completion.
- Each student must complete an Avid evaluation form upon completion of every Avid Official Course.

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COURSE BOOK REQUIREMENTS

ALPs will promote Avid's Official Curriculum by:

- ALPs must use current, Avid Official Course Books for all Avid courses.
- One Course book must be purchased and used for each student enrolled in an Avid Official Course.
- ALPs must meet a minimum course delivery requirement of six (6) classes or a minimum of 40 students per calendar year.
- Partners are welcome to augment the Avid curriculum with additional materials that help tailor Avid's courses to their existing educational plans, however ALPs cannot offer their own developed or third-party developed course books if the course directly competes with specific courses in the Avid curriculum.
- Avid Official Courses taught by ALPs can be delivered in a multi-day, multi-week, or multimonth format to accommodate a broad range of student and partner needs.

ALP Authorization Process

Steps for becoming an ALP are detailed below.

- 1. **Apply:** Candidate completes the online application: Contact your Regional Training Partner Program Manager, contact details are listed in Appendix D.
- 2. **Interview:** Interview and discussions facilitated by the Avid Regional Training Partner Program Manager, regarding current system configurations, instructor training, and other relevant details of the partner program.
- 3. **Legal Agreement:** If approved to move forward, the partner candidate receives an executable ALP agreement, which they sign and return to Avid along with the initial program fee for each location. Note, ALPs may only offer Avid Certification Exams for courses they are authorized to teach.
- 4. **Certify:** Instructor candidates complete the instructor certification process as outlined in *Appendix C: Instructor Certification Requirements*. ALPs applying to the Avid Certified Professional Program may also name their exam Administrator and Proctor and send them through the requisite training.
- 5. **Enable:** The ALP access to Avid's Training Administration system and online scheduling system is granted. ALP may order Avid Official Course Books and offer Avid certification exams.
- 6. **ALP:** The ALP is listed on Avid.com in Avid's Worldwide Training Partner directory and may begin teaching Avid Official Courses.

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Appendix A: Avid Curriculum Overview and System Requirements


