FY17-18 Jobs for America's Graduates (JAGS) Program Funding

JAG Program funding in FY17-18 is comprised primarily of Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) funds (through Department of Children and Family Services), Pre-Employment Transition Services (PETS) funds (through Louisiana Workforce Commission), and Minimum Foundation Program (MFP) Career Development Fund (CDF). A few districts will receive AT&T and Entergy funds. Attached is a spreadsheet that outlines the distribution by Local Education Agency (LEA) by fund source. Not all recipients received all funding sources.

- The TANF and PETS funds are considered federal funds for accounting purposes.
 - 1. Federal guidelines around use of funds and records retention applies to both the TANF and PETS funds.
- The AT&T and Entergy funds are considered other restricted revenue for accounting purposes.

Target Dates:

• The target date for the eGMS application to open no later than the week of **October 23rd**.

Regulations:

- Grants provided to fund JAG programs have unique rules/regulations and payment processes.
- Review and be alert to special situations in order to maximize the funding available and avoid audit questions.

Budget/Reimbursement:

- Funding sources are intended to be braided together in order to provide total funding of \$50,000 per program.
- A budget must be completed in eGMS to include: TANF, PETS, AT&T, and Entergy
 - o MFP Career Development Funds are not budgeted through eGMS.
- The following reimbursement process will be utilized for each funding type:
 - o **PETS, AT&T and Entergy funds** claims for these funds will utilize the normal reimbursement process through eGMS.
 - TANF Funds claims for these funds will utilize the normal reimbursement process through eGMS.
 - MFP Career Development Funds (CDF) Payments are distributed by the LDOE with no
 action necessary from the LEA. CDF funds are paid in the early spring once the course count
 data collections is final.

Funding Sources:

TANF Federal Funds:

• These funds are based on an allocation of dollars not provided by other grants.

PETS Federal Funds:

- These funds are allocated to LEAs participating in the PETs program and the number of eligible participating students.
- The amount of PETS funding an LEA is eligible to receive is capped so the number of students for which an LEA may be paid PETs funding is capped.
 - o If the number of students an LEA enrolls exceeds the student cap, the LEA PETs allocation remains the same.
 - The LEA will be responsible for identifying other funding sources to support the educational services for students over the cap.
- Any LEAs first receiving a program allocation in October 2017 will not receive PETs funding this year but provided other funding.

MFP Career Development Funds (CDF):

- JAG programs will be eligible for the first time for CDF funds through the MFP allocation.
- The CDF allocation is based on the number of JAG courses in each LEA (1 student = 1 JAG course).
- The extra funding generated through the addition of these courses is available to fund the JAG program.
- The amount on the allocation is an estimate at this time.
- The actual allocation will be based on the number of courses reported to the LDOE in January 2018.
- MFP Allocations will be adjusted in January as needed.

Travel:

- Any district that is receiving TANF funds must charge any travel to the TANF funds.
- Travel under the TANF funding must be in accordance with PPM49.
