Jump Start Career Development Fund: Year End Report

Districts, charter schools and special schools are reminded to complete the **Career Development Fund year-end report** and submit it to <u>JumpStart@la.gov</u> by July 15, 2015. Districts, charter schools and special schools received a 6% MFP adder (state funding portion only) for student enrollments in "technical" CTE courses. This adder equaled ~\$240 per student enrollment by course. The CDF adder was in addition to the current 6% MFP adder for any student enrollment in a CTE course. There was a minimum CDF allocation of \$25,000 per district or \$10,000 per charter/special school.
