Update On Value Added/Act 54 Information

Review

- Act 54 passed into law in 2010
 - Requires 50% of a teacher's evaluation to be based on student growth
 - Currently 33% of teachers will have value added
 - ▼ Remaining 67% will use the Non-Tested Grades and Subjects (NTGS) growth measures
 - Remaining 50% will be based on administrator observations
- Act 54 new requirements effective 2012-2013

Value Added Portion

- Value added data is in its 3rd year of piloting
 - o 1st year: 24 schools − roster verification and results from 2008-2009 data
 - 2nd year: 328 schools across 19 districts— roster verification (statewide) and results from 2009-2010 data
 - 3rd year: Statewide roster verification and results from 2010-2011 data
 - *Results will be released again statewide that reflect the 2011-2012 school year
 - ▼ These results are tentatively scheduled to be released by the end of May 2012.

What's New

- Roster verification for the 2011-2012 school year will include grades and teachers in 3-8 and those 9-12 courses with end of course exams
- New administration of 2nd grade IOWA assessment
 - Allows for 3rd grade teachers to receive a value added score (gets us up to roughly 39% of teachers)

What's New cont.

- New Overall Composite Percentile and Rating Scale Score in results
 - Overall Composite Percentile allows teachers to get an idea of how they compare to other teachers statewide
 - Rating Scale Score will be the actual piece of information that is combined with other 50% to determine final evaluation score
 - ★ ACEE currently working on standard setting to determine rating scale
 - **▼** Recommendations by ACEE will then be sent on to BESE for approval

Quick Preview of NTGS

- For teachers and courses where value added data not available
- Teacher workgroups currently working on method for non-tested grades and subjects
 - Common assessments and Student learning targets proposed

Quick Preview of COMPASS

- Clear, Overall Measure of their Performance to Analyze and Support Success
- Working with educators to design method
- Piloting to start in January 2012
