

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NSECD

Nonpublic Schools Early Childhood Development Program

What is the NSECD?

The NSECD Program provides at-risk four-year-old children access to high quality, developmentally appropriate prekindergarten classes in either a qualified nonpublic school or Type 3 child care setting.

How does it work?

If you are selected to participate as a provider in the NSECD Program, you will receive monthly tuition reimbursements for participating NSECD students who meet program attendance requirements.

Are all my 4-year-old students eligible?

No. Only children of families whose household income falls at or below 185% of the Federal Poverty Level are eligible to participate in the NSECD Program.

How do I apply?

The provider application process for 2016-2017 will begin in October 2016. All applications are submitted through the eGMS system. If you would like to gain access to the application, just fill out the Information Request and we will notify you at the appropriate time.
