

This document outlines definitions for the terminology used in the *Program Approval: Initial Application Portal*.

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Applicants	This application portal can be used by: 1. Currently approved teacher preparation providers 2. Institutions seeking to become an approved provider	
Pathway Type	The two categories of applicants will add new certification areas to the following pathway types: 1. Currently approved teacher preparation providers • Current pathway (an existing pathway) • New pathway (one not currently offered or existing) 2. Institutions seeking to become an approved provider • New pathway (one not currently offered or existing)	
Pathway and Route	New certification areas can be added to a <i>current</i> or <i>new</i> pathway type for the following pathway and routes outlined below: 1. Undergraduate 2. Post-baccalaureate: Certification-only 3. Post-baccalaureate: Master's 4. Post-baccalaureate: Practitioner Teacher Program	
Submitting multiple applications	Applicants will submit one application for a pathway type for <i>each</i> pathway and route. Therefore, a currently approved provider could submit up to 8 applications and an institution seeking approval could submit up to 4 applications as outlined below:

Provider Profile	Currently approved teacher preparation providers who completed an application in the assurances portal do demonstrate alignment to new policies for currently approved programs will already have a profile. Changes can be made to the profile and will be reflected in both portals. Institutions seeking to become approved providers will need to create a profile. Select "I am seeking to become a NEW provider" for the Name of University or Private Provider dropdown in the profile section.
