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SER LAA 1 and Act 833 Changes January 2015



SER January IEP Updates

In response to new policy changes, several changes to the SER IEP will occur on January 14th.

Act 833

- Act 833 was established to allow a student's IEP team to determine promotion to the next grade or issue a high school diploma/graduation based on individual performance criteria under certain circumstances
- To comply with Act 833, the Department of Education must monitor the performance of students with disabilities for school systems with high rates of students with disabilities performing below expected levels

• LAA 1 eligibility criteria has been revised per approved BESE policy

Identifying Students Under Act 833

The law identifies three situations in which a student qualifies for promotion or graduation under Act 833:

Eligible for Promotion:

 In the year prior to the year in which there is a state or local benchmark on state assessments required for promotion, the student does not meet the benchmark score;

Eligible for Graduation:

- The student does not meet the state established benchmarks on two out of the three state assessments in 6th, 7th, or 8th grade;
- The student does not achieve a score of fair, good, or excellent on two administrations of an EOC test

Identifying Students Under Act 833

The Program/Services page of the IEP has added a block for determining Act 833 Eligibility.

• Determine eligibility by selecting Yes (Y) or No (N)

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Identifying Students Under Act 833

- If "Y" is selected, a new page (Act 833) on the IEP form must be added
- At the top right hand corner of the page, click on <u>add/delete forms to IEP</u>
- Choose Act 833 from the list and save.
- The form is now ready to complete in the **IEP Forms** drop down box at the top of the page.
- Once you choose the form
 - The IEP team will have to indicate initial eligibility determination date;
 - Check which of the three eligibility qualifications the student meets; and
 - The IEP team will certify that the information is accurate

This will apply to all new or amended IEPs after January 14th

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LAA 1 Updates

BESE has approved revision to the LAA 1 eligibility criteria to include students falling between 2.0 and 2.9 standard deviations below the testing mean.

Criterion 1 – Evidence of a Significant Cognitive Disability or Multiple Disabilities

The first criterion has been divided into 3 different levels.

- 1a. 3 or more standard deviations below the mean, any grade level
- 1b. 2.3-2.9 standard deviations below the mean after completing 5th grade
- 1c. 2.0-2.29 standard deviations below the mean after completing 5th grade (additional documentation required)

The LAA1 Participation Form is now digital and added to the IEP forms if selected.

LAA1 Eligibility

- Under Alternate Assessment on the Program/Services Page of the IEP, choose LAA 1
 - At the top right hand corner of the page, click on <u>add/delete forms to IEP</u>
 - Choose LAA 1 from the list and save.
 - The form is now ready to complete in the **IEP Forms** drop down box at the top of the page.

Note: If LAA 1 is not checked, no new form will be added.

Once you bring up the LAA 1 form, you will complete the form in its new digital format.

- You will first complete the Criterion #1 box.
 - $\circ~$ choose from the new 3 options for Criterion 1 $\,$
 - o If A. or B. is selected, you will then continue through the remaining criteria.
 - Note All statements must be answered with an "Agree" for the student to be eligible for LAA 1.
- The parent must complete all 3 statements in the *Parental Understanding* Box
- The LAA 1 approval must be given; and
- Name of the IEP members in attendance must be provided.

LAA1 Forms of the IEP

When completing Criteria 1. if C. is selected *Additional Documentation for Using Criteria 1. C* appears.

- Four questions must be answered. All four answer must be *Yes* for the student to be eligible for LAA 1.
 - When answering the four question, sources of evidence must be checked.
 - A minimum of one source must be checked for each answer. Multiple sources can be provided to ensure eligibility. The evidence must be on the IEP or in the student's IEP folder.
- The LAA 1 Approval must be given; and
- Names of the IEP members in attendance must be provided.
