Registration Process

 - All seats are first come, first served.
 - Districts will pay Eureka Math directly for all additional seats beyond those the LDE is providing.
 - After May 23, the LDE will equally distribute all unused seats to interested districts.

English Language Arts Session Information

The English language arts trainings will focus participants on learning how to implement the first unit of the guidebook. In grades K-2, there will be additional sessions for implementing the skills strand of the Core Knowledge program. Participants will either participate in the guidebook training or the Core Knowledge training.

Session Objectives: Participants will

- Read, understand, and write and speak about complex texts
- Examine how unit lessons build toward the unit assessments
- Develop an initial plan for adapting and implementing a guidebook unit

Session Overview: The session will begin by building participant knowledge in reading, understanding, and expressing understanding about complex texts. Participants will engage in a guidebook lesson and then discuss the elements of the lesson that most support student understanding of reading, writing, speaking, listening, and language. Participants will then examine how the various lessons build across a unit and work with other participants to develop an implementation plan for a guidebook unit.

Session Logistics:

The sessions will follow the timeline below. Participants must register for the full two days. Seats are first come, first served. If the session you wish to register for is closed, please sign up for the wait list. If we have high demand for one grade band over another we will work as best we can to accommodate the requests. The waitlist will help us make those determinations, but you cannot also register for another session.
