Step-by-Step Foundational Supports (LIFT in Grades 3-12)		
September 14	Session 1: Using Data to Determine Starting Point	This session will provide a flowchart and process for determining what students need additional literacy screening in grades 3-12. We will also discuss what screeners are appropriate and what structures need to be in place in the classroom in order for the data to be reliable.
September 21	Session 2: How to Conduct a Fluency Screener	This session will discuss the parts of a fluency screener and will walk participants through how to administer a fluency screener to students as well as next steps.
September 28	Session 3: How to Administer the Skills Probe	This session will discuss the next step in the LIFT Kit, the skills probe, and how to administer the skills probe to students as well as next steps.
