

Literacy Grab & Go Infants (0 - 1½-year-olds)

Activity Title: Mystery Toy

Activity Purpose: Help promote curiosity, language, and object permanence with this fun way to play with familiar objects.

Rationale

Similar to peekaboo, this activity helps your child understand that people and objects exist even when they can't see or hear them. Once a child develops this understanding, this activity helps them see how hidden objects can be described and guessed.

Materials: toys or familiar objects

Description of Activity:

- Place three familiar toys under a sheet, towel or another covering. 1.
- 2. Wonder aloud about what object is hidden, describing what you can about the hidden object.
 - You can say things like, "I wonder what's under the sheet. It is small. It has a 0 round top."
- 3. Then, countdown from three and reveal the toy, naming what it is.
 - For example, "3-2-1...it's a toy car!"

Lagniappe: You can add mystery play to any activity. From hiding and revealing the shoes that will be worn

to snacks your child will eat.
