

K-2 Teachers Session Redelivery Plan Session 11: Small Groups

Session Objectives:

By the end of this session, participants will be able to:

- develop effective small group instruction plans, including how to identify gaps in learning, develop targeted interventions and extensions, and what the students who are not a part of your small group can be doing to support their reading growth.

 Discuss how teachers plan for small group instruction. Provide copies of optional <u>small group planning</u> <u>template</u>, and ask teachers to reflect on how this template is different than what they may have used in the past.

• Slide 11 - Support Staff

• Read through slides, and discuss how support staff are currently used and how they can be used to support instruction during small group time.

• Slides 12-14 - What are the other students doing?

- Read through the slides and discuss the importance of keeping students meaningfully engaged in literacy work that they are able to complete independently while you are working with small groups. Ask them to reflect on their current practice and what they might do differently moving forward.
- Slides 15-16 Final Thoughts





- Recap key learning and ask Engage question.
- <u>Engage</u>: What is something that you have struggled with when it comes to small group instruction? What will you do differently this year to address that struggle?
