

Literacy Grab & Go Preschool (3 - 4-year-olds)

Activity Title: Dice Count Game Domain: Language

Activity Purpose: Build your child's math and language skills with this easy dice game.

Rationale

Math is full of important language and literacy opportunities. An important skill for four-year-olds is the ability to verbally count by ones to 10.

Materials: • one or two dice

Description of Activity:

- 1. Have your child roll one or two dice and count the number of dots they see.
- 2. Then depending on what they roll, have them start at that number and count up to 10.

Lagniappe: Enjoy building your child's math and literacy skills with this fun indoor playtime activity.

Focus on rolling one dice and have your child count the dots on the dice accurately. It's important that your child says only one number when pointing to just one dot. If the dots and dice are too small, draw the arrangement of dots on the dice on a piece of paper so your child can point and count more easily.
