Scope of Work:

The specific responsibilities of Teacher Leader Advisors will vary depending on the content area and time of year but will include the following types of activities:

- Evaluating the quality of publisher-submitted curricular materials
- Creating and revising high-quality instructional tasks and resources in math, science, and STEM
- Updating the ELA Guidebooks and adapting them for Students with Significant Cognitive Disabilities
- Scoring and annotating student work samples
- Developing and facilitating professional development sessions for fellow Louisiana educators
- Raising awareness among Louisiana educators of the tools and resources available in the Louisiana Teacher Toolbox

Becoming a Teacher Leader Advisor requires educators to commit to completing additional work outside of their regular duties:

- Average five (5) hours per week (varies from week to week)
- Virtual training

Applications are currently open for the following areas:

- Early Childhood Education (birth-five)
 Instructional Materials Review
- Foundational Skills/Reading Intervention Instructional Materials Review
- K-12 ELA Content Support and ELA Instructional Materials Review

- K-12 Math Instructional Materials Review
- K-12 Science Content Support and Science Instructional Materials Review
- K-12 STEM Content Support
- K-12 Students with Significant Cognitive Disabilities

Who should apply?

There is a specific need for expert educators in the areas of early literacy, intervention specialist, Early Childhood (Birth to 3 and pre-K), and K-12 science and STEM. We also need K-12 teachers across ELA and math content areas and librarians. Special education teachers who specialize in these areas are also encouraged to apply.
