WHAT PROJECTS MIGHT AN EDTECH: DIGITAL LEARNING TEACHER LEADER ADVISOR COMPLETE?

EdTech: Digital Learning TLAs are a group of exceptional educators from across Louisiana who play an influential role in supporting the success of K-12 educators in integrating technology into daily instruction. The TLAs will use their robust knowledge of teaching and learning to review and create the next wave of high-quality instructional materials and training tools that will be used by thousands of teachers across the state. Current projects for EdTech: Digital Learning Content TLAs include:

- creating and reviewing instructional resources such as the guides to integrating technology in the [Educational Technology for Teachers Resources Library](#); and
 - developing and facilitating professional development sessions.
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WHO SHOULD APPLY?

Current educators with experience in integrating educational technology tools or training teachers on how to integrate educational technology tools into classroom instruction are eligible to apply. Educators of all roles and content areas are encouraged to apply, you do not need to be a school-site Teacher Leader to apply. Applicants should

- be **adept in meaningful technology integration**;
 - contribute **innovative ideas** to future and current projects;
 - be able to **meet deadlines**; and
 - have the **capacity to devote time** towards additional projects outside of the normal work day.
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WHAT COMMITMENTS ARE REQUIRED?

- dedicate **5 to 10 hours per week** for assignments outside of normal employment hours
 - attend the required **trainings** and **check-ins** with the workgroup manager and potentially other TLAs.
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WHAT ARE THE BENEFITS OF BEING A TEACHER LEADER ADVISOR?

- compensation for **completed project deliverables** (as assigned) which range from **\$300 to \$500 each** with total TLA contracts ranging from \$3,000 to \$5,000;
 - **training** and **feedback** by Louisiana Department of Education staff members throughout the project;
 - **deep understanding** of the curriculum tools and resources the LDOE provides to educators; and the opportunity to **network** and **collaborate** with peer educators and LDOE leadership.
