SUBJECT: Quarter 1: Student Scholarships for Educational Excellence Program

FY 2012-2013 Minimum Foundation Program (MFP) Allocation

Per Senate Concurrent Resolution 99 (SCR 99) of the 2012 Regular Session of the Legislature, transfers of scholarship payments shall be made by the Department of Education on behalf of the responsible city or parish school districts to eligible nonpublic schools and eligible public schools in four equal installments throughout the school year.
