**FY 2014-15 Minimum Foundation Program (MFP) Allocation**

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Per Senate Concurrent Resolution 55 of the 2014 Regular Session of the Legislature, two mid-year adjustments are provided during the fiscal year based on student membership count dates of October and February.

**Mid-Year Adjustments for Students:**

School systems and schools will receive an adjustment for the base per pupil amount times the number of students gained or lost from the October 1, 2014 Mid-Year Adjustment, and one-half of the base per pupil amount times the number of students gained or lost from the February 1, 2015 Mid-Year Adjustment. The adjustment in funding to accommodate these increases and decreases is included in the March 2015 payments.

**Final Local Per Pupil Amounts for Charter Schools:**

The local per pupil amount for charter schools is finalized according to Louisiana Revised Statute 17:3995. The State share per pupil is based on the per pupil amount included in the FY2014-15 Budget Letter (Circular No. 1156) issued on June 24, 2014. The local revenue representation amount has been recalculated to reflect the local revenues received during the prior year and reported in each district's FY2013-14 Annual Financial Report (AFR), and the October 1, 2014 student count reported in the Student Information System (SIS).
