SUBJECT: FY 2015-16 HB1 Appropriations

During the 2015 Regular Session, the legislature and the governor agreed to a budget that provided an allocation of \$44.2 million for public schools. This funding was provided outside of the MFP formula as part of House Bill 1, the general appropriations bill. This appropriation includes:

• \$36.2 million which is roughly equivalent to a 1.375% increase in the Minimum Foundation Program Base Per Pupil Amount

According to HB 1 these funds are intended to "sustain the certificated classroom teacher pay raise provided for in fiscal year 2013-14." This allocation permits but does not require districts to award additional pay increases. Instead, these funds are to sustain base-building pay raises or one-time salary supplements provided in 2013-14.

The total allocation of the \$36.2 Appropriation for each district and school is attached. A payment schedule detailing the timing of the release of these funds will be distributed in a separate communication in the coming week.

• \$5.4 million for High Cost Services

These funds are needed to support the costs of services for students with significant disabilities. This brings the total funding available up to \$13.4 million across all funding sources (\$4 million in MFP, \$5.4 million in State funds and \$4 million in federal IDEA funds). These funds are being released through the application process located within the electronic grants management system (eGMS).

• \$2.6 million for Supplemental Course Allocation

The Supplemental Course Allocation (SCA) will support dual enrollment and Course Choice. With this allocation, the total available for these activities increases to \$10.4 million from all funding sources (\$7.8 million in MFP and \$2.6 million in State funds). Information on the distribution of these funds will be distributed in a separate communication in the coming week.
