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### Message from the Superintendent

Dear Colleagues,

As a result of your efforts, Louisiana's educational ranking has increased to a record high and students are benefitting with stronger academic outcomes. In a state that has been long-challenged with educational outcomes, we have more work to accomplish.

Teachers have played a core role in our recent improvements and should be commended. However, teachers often ask me, "Can you make my job just a little bit easier?" So, we rolled up our sleeves and went to work. I called together a group of nearly 30 educators from across the state and tasked them to solve for key concerns. Recently, with Governor Jeff Landry by my side, we released a set of recommendations to support Louisiana's teachers. These are common sense solutions that elevate the teaching profession while seeking to restore law and order to school campuses across Louisiana.

These recommendations keep students as a priority and do not infringe on parental rights. While some require state action, others must be handled at the system and/or school level. I'm hopeful we can continue working together to improve the educational system in Louisiana. Thanks for your collaboration.

# Assessments, Accountability, and Analytics

#### **ELPT/ELPT Connect Score Release**

Please share with school leaders and testing coordinators.

The spring 2024 ELPT/ELPT Connect scores were released on Monday, June 3 in the TIDE portal. There is no embargo on individual student reports. Schools and systems are responsible for disseminating reports to parents. Summarized results should not be released before the LDOE posts summary results.

Students who meet the definition of proficiency should be reclassified in EdLink at the beginning of 2024-2025. Students who do not meet the definition of proficiency must continue to test, even if services are refused.

During assessment data certification in late August, schools will be able to review how results are used in their SPS and request changes based on documentation. When ELPT post-data certification rosters are released with fall 2024 school performance scores, annual targets for students will be provided in the file.

### LEAP 2025 DRC Student Corrections Online Cleanup

Please share with school leaders and testing coordinators.

The annual DRC INSIGHT Student Corrections Online Cleanup will open on June 10 and will close on June 17. There is no possibility of extension. This process provides DTCs and STCs with the option to correct demographic data that may cause issues with matching and to apply accountability codes for students with a legitimate, documented excuse from testing.

The only persons who will have access to DRC INSIGHT are current district test coordinators and school test coordinators who have been provided access through their DTC. The LDOE does not manage STC access. School test coordinators can apply changes directly. District test coordinators should monitor each school's progress using the status report.

### **Update: 2023-2024 Teacher Roster Verification for VAM**

Please share with data managers, school leaders, and teachers.

The <u>Curriculum Verification and Results (CVR) Reporting Portal</u> roster verification ensures that teachers are assigned to the correct courses and classroom rosters of students for the purposes of value-added (VAM) analysis. The data in CVR

will be used to calculate a teacher's VAM score even if the teacher and/or the principal do not verify the roster. Teachers instructing ELA, Math, Science (grades 4-8), and Algebra I, Geometry, English I and English II EOC courses (all grades) should verify their rosters as they are eligible to receive VAM scores. Social Studies rosters will not be available in the CVR because a new Social Studies test is being piloted in the 2023-2024 school year. Teachers do not need to verify any Social Studies class roster.

May 6-June 7 CVR will be open for roster verification. Please note the verification window has been extended until June 7. This process is required and allows teachers and principals the ability to verify and correct records for specific courses and students. Data managers will track verification completion at the school system and school level in the system.
