Standard and CTE Employment Certificates

Please share with CTE supervisors, administrators, WBL teachers, and counselors.

All students in work-based learning programs are required to hold an employment certificate. The specific type (Minor Employment Certificate vs. CTE Employment Certificate) is dependent on the nature of the opportunity.

Internships: Students participating in high-dosage opportunities (a total of 106.2 hours of on-the-job training) must obtain a **CTE Employment Certificate**.

CTE Employment Certificates:

- Require termination date
- Completed and signed by: Training employer, parent/guardian, teacher-coordinator, and student-trainee
- CTE Teacher-Coordinator completes and submits the electronic CTE Employment Certificate via the Louisiana Works website
- Prohibited occupations exemptions exist

Cooperative Education (Co-Op): Students employed in a part-time job (ex, Super 1, Raising Cane's, etc.) must obtain a [Standard Minor Employment Certificate](#).

Standard Employment Certificates:

- No expiration date
- Application to employ a minor
- Completed and signed by: Employer representative, parent/guardian
- Prohibited occupations apply

Industry-Based Credential Bundles Update

Please share with CTE supervisors, administrators, WBL teachers, and counselors.

Louisiana Works (formerly the Louisiana Workforce Commission) will lead the development of industry-based credential bundles. Bundle concepts will be shared with regional economic development organizations, LCTCS, and LDOE to validate workforce demand and ensure alignment with post-secondary pathways.

Please note, school systems will not create or submit bundles themselves; however, they will play an important role in the process by recommending employer partners to LA Works for engagement. This approach is intended to ensure that bundles are responsive to employer needs, aligned with

labor market demand, and provide students with a clear path from high school into training, postsecondary education, and career opportunities.

Q & A With COounselor COnnect!

Q: What is the importance and benefit of ***aligning student interests with academic courses?***

A: Decisions about academic course progressions should be made to align with student interests. This process should begin in the *middle grades* and continue into high school while increasing in specificity and focus. Tools such as interest inventories can guide discussions with students about their future career aspirations. Understanding the student's career aspirations and desired high school experience will help the counselor support the student in:

- Making informed decisions regarding both academic and technical coursework.
- Engaging in coursework that not only provides them with the foundational skills needed to persevere into the diploma pathway of choice, but is also aligned closely to relevant and authentic contexts.
- Gaining access to extracurricular activities that align with their long-term goals.
- Preparing students for post-secondary education or careers that correspond with their personal and professional goals.
- Understanding what academic and career opportunities are available in their own community.

Scholarship/Funding Opportunities

Scholarship awards can range significantly, from modest amounts, such as \$50-\$500, from local organizations to substantial sums, including full tuition, from larger institutions. Smaller scholarships, despite their lesser amounts, can be a great way to secure funding and often have fewer applicants.
