TEACHER AND LEADER PIPELINE

STATE-APPROVED MENTOR TEACHER AND CONTENT LEADER TRAININGS

In October 2018, <u>BESE approved regulations to establish new state credentials for classroom teachers</u> who serve as mentors to aspiring teachers and as curriculum experts within their schools. The Mentor Teacher certificate will be required for teachers who mentor undergraduate or post-baccalaureate residents beginning in September 2020, eventually replacing the previously required Supervisor of Student Teaching credential.

For the past two years, the Department has offered training through competitively selected vendors. BESE has begun to approve additional providers to offer Mentor and Content Leader training.

This month, BESE will consider the programs listed below for approval.

PRAXIS EXAM UPDATES

In response to recommendations made by the Louisiana Association of Colleges for Teacher Education (LACTE), BESE approved revisions to the Social Studies PRAXIS exam (5086) score in June 2019. The current required score is 160. Approved policy revised the required score to 153.

Educational Testing Service (ETS) is retiring or changing several of the currently adopted PRAXIS exams. This month, BESE will consider the below updates:

- Adoption of a new PRAXIS Core Academic Skills for Educators: Reading (5713), Writing (5723), and Mathematics (5733)
- Adoption of a new PRAXIS Teaching Reading Exam (5206)
- Adoption of a new PRAXIS School Superintendent Assessment (6991)

PRAXIS Core Academic Skills for Education

- Effective September 1, 2019, educators may take either the currently adopted exams or the newly proposed exams.
- The new exams (5713, 5723, and 5733) are required effective August 1, 2020.

PRAXIS Teaching Reading Exam and the PRAXIS School Superintendent Assessment,

- Effective September 1, 2019, educators may take either the currently adopted exams or the newly proposed exams.
- The new exams (5206 and 6991) are required effective August 1, 2020.

School Leaders Licensure Assessment

- Prior to September 1, 2019, candidates should take exam #6011.
- Effective September 1, 2019, candidates should take exam #6990.

GPA UPDATE

As a result of 2019 legislation, R.S. 17:7.1A.3 allows post-baccalaureate teacher preparation programs to **conditionally** admit candidates with a **GPA of less than 2.50**. The law also allows candidates to be recommended for initial certification if they meet the below requirements:

- Successfully complete an interview with the admissions officer
- Achieve a grade point average of 3.00 or higher in post-baccalaureate program courses by the end of the candidate's first twelve credit hours (for credit-bearing programs)
- Demonstrate mastery of competencies as required by the program administrator and by the school system in which the applicant completes required clinical practice, and satisfactorily completes all program requirements as set forth by the state board, including any requirements for clinical practice, at graduation

BESE will consider updates to bring policy into alignment with this new law at their August meeting. The Department will also disseminate guidance for the interview protocol after BESE considers policy.
