## **Educator Talent and Workforce Development**

### **CBC for Certification vs. CCCBC for Employment**

Please share with early learning centers, educators, HR directors, school leaders, system leaders, teacher candidates, and teacher preparation providers.

The Criminal Background Check (CBC) for certification is separate from the Child Care Criminal Background Check (CCCBC), run for employment in an early learning center. Effective January 1, <u>LA R.S. 17:8.9</u> requires a separate CBC for certification. A single background check cannot legally be used for multiple purposes, as the FBI and LA State Police prohibit this.

Please use the <u>Educator Fingerprinting Packet</u> with the LDOE's Certification & Background Credentialing service code to schedule fingerprinting for certification. Applicants will know when their CBCs for certification have been received, reviewed, and cleared for certification when the LDOE has <u>issued/added the "Clear Credential" record</u> to the individual's certification record, viewable on <u>www.teachlouisiana.net</u>. At that time, if applicants need to apply for or renew the Early Childhood Ancillary Certificate (ECAC), download the <u>current ECAC application (initial or renewal) with the newly revised Professional Conduct form</u> and submit it, including all required pieces of the application packet, as a new case through our online certification portal.

<u>School Systems with Idemia's EYO Workstations May Fingerprint for Certification</u>
Please share with early learning centers, educators, HR directors, school leaders, system leaders, teacher candidates, and teacher preparation providers.

As of January 6, the Louisiana State Police (LSP) has indicated the following school systems have their own EYO workstations and may fingerprint individuals for certification purposes:

Please use the <u>Educator Fingerprinting Packet</u> to schedule fingerprinting for certification using the LDOE's Certification & Background Credentialing service code and scheduling link provided in the packet, along with the school system-provided location code. The location code is used in place of the zip code when scheduling. Please see step 7 in LSP's <u>scheduling document</u>.

School systems should be aware that if they fingerprint an applicant under their own service code, the LDOE does not receive a copy of that CBC as that is for employment purposes. A single CBC cannot be used for multiple purposes, and therefore, fingerprinting for certification must be done using the LDOE's Certification & Background Credentialing service code.

BESE adopted new policy in April of 2024 concerning work-based learning instructor requirements for teacher certification. The policy requires that a work-based learning teacher shall hold one of the following:

- Valid CTTIE Certification or Agriculture Certification
- Valid Level 2 Louisiana Teaching Certificate, with at least three years of work experience other than classroom instruction
- Valid Level 2 Louisiana Teaching Certificate and completion of a work-based learning workshop by an approved provider
