Mentor Teacher, Content Leader, Louisiana Leadership Assessment Series Updates Please share with principals and teacher leaders.

The LDOE has been notified that Bloomboard will no longer offer the Louisiana Content Leader Assessment or the Louisiana Leadership Assessment Series (LLAS), effective June 19. All active assessments must be completed on or before June 19. Portfolios and assessment materials will no longer be accessible after the June 19 discontinue date. Bloomboard has also stated that the Louisiana Mentor Teacher Assessment Series will be paused effective June 19 for updates. The revised model will launch on June 24 and include a price increase to \$500 for the assessment series.

2025-2026 LEADS Evaluator Recertification

Per <u>Bulletin 130</u>, evaluators and designated observers must certify annually before evaluating educators. All evaluators and designated observers who attended LEADS training during the 2024-2025 school year have now been assigned the 2025-2026 annual recertification assessment. Individuals may now log in to <u>EdLink Security</u> to access Canopy and begin taking the assessment.

For the 2024-2025 school year only, those who took the assessment from January through April were automatically marked as complete. Certificates can be accessed in Canopy.

LES Evaluation Closeout

Please share with data managers, human resource directors, school leaders, and system leaders.

Systems may begin finalizing educator evaluations in the Louisiana Evaluation System (LES) portal. As part of this process, educators should complete the following tasks based on their role:

- Teachers should enter their Student Learning Targets (SLTs), input self-assessment scores, assess students, report SLT results, and submit the Principal Survey.
- Counselors and school leaders are responsible for entering self-assessment scores. If data is available, they should also enter their SLTs and report the results.
- Evaluators are encouraged to check rosters, enter and complete observations, accept and rate SLTs, and enter End-of-Year (EOY) conference scores.

2025-2026 Program Approval Fall Cycle

Louisiana SUN Bucks: Summer Nutrition Support for Kids

Please share with data managers, nutrition managers, and school leaders.

SUN Bucks provides a one-time \$120 benefit to help families buy groceries for each eligible school-aged child during summer break. Most children will be automatically enrolled if they received SNAP, FITAP, KCSP, or income-based Medicaid between July 2024 and August 2025, or if they attend a school offering free or reduced-price meals through the National School Lunch or Breakfast Program.

Children who attend Community Eligibility Provision (CEP) schools will need to apply once the application becomes available this spring. Benefits will be distributed in mid-May, loaded onto existing EBT cards, or mailed on new cards in plain envelopes. Families should ensure their mailing address is current and keep their child's EBT card for future use.

Public School Transfers

Louisiana Revised Statute 17:4035.1 and BESE policy in *Bulletin 741 - Louisiana Handbook for School Administrators*, Chapter 35, provide for parents to request a child's enrollment in a public school other than that for which the student is zoned to attend. <u>Additional guidance</u> is available on the <u>BESE website</u>, along with the form required for appeals of denied intra-district transfer requests. Please plan to submit the data for the annual report by September 30, 2025, via Jotform and an updated version of the district transfer policy by January 30, 2026 to <u>educationpolicy@la.gov</u>.

2024-2025 Teacher Roster Verification for VAM

Please share with school leaders, system leaders, and teachers.

The Louisiana Educator Portal (LEP) roster verification ensures that teachers are assigned to the correct courses and classroom rosters of students for the purposes of value-added (VAM) analysis. The data in LEP will be used to calculate a teacher's VAM score even if the teacher and/or the principal do not verify the roster. Teachers instructing ELA, Math, Science (grades 4-8), and Algebra I, Geometry, English I, and English II LEAP High School assessment-eligible courses (all grades) should verify their rosters as they are eligible to receive VAM scores. Social Studies rosters will not be available in LEP because a new Social Studies test was piloted in the 2024-2025 school year. Teachers do not need to verify any Social Studies class roster this year.

LEP will be open May 5- May 30 for roster verification. This mandatory process allows teachers and principals to verify and correct records for specific courses and students. Data managers will track verification completion at the school system and school level in the system.
