# **Message from the State Superintendent**

Dear Colleagues,

<u>Statewide results from the end-of-year literacy screener</u> show continued reading progress for K–3 students. This year, we saw a 17-point increase in the percentage of students reading on grade level compared to the beginning of the school year. Compared to last year's end-of-year data, K–3 students improved by nine points.

These outcomes reflect the impact of strong teaching, sound policy, and strategic investments. School system-level data will be shared with you soon, ahead of public release.

Please verify that the data is accurate, as these counts will be used to run the analysis and data disaggregation for the public report. If the data does not accurately reflect seclusions and restraints in your school system for the 2024–2025 school year, update the information in SER. Submit a new seclusion and restraint handbook if your LEA revised a previously submitted handbook to <a href="mailto:specialeducation@la.gov">specialeducation@la.gov</a>. All updates in SER need to be completed, and any new or revised policy must be submitted by July 1 to be reflected in the final report.

# **Teacher Leader Summit Session Registration Open**

Session registration for Teacher Leader Summit 2025 is now open. To register for sessions, attendees must download and log into the Cvent app.

How to access the <u>Cvent app</u>:



- Step 1: **Scan the QR code** above using your preferred mobile device. First time users will be prompted to download the Cvent app.
- Step 2: Enter the **Event ID: ECvFbTLS2025**
- Step 3: Log in using the attendee's first name, last name, and email ID. A 6-digit verification code will be sent to the registered email. Enter the code to complete the login and access the app.

If attendees are unable to access the app, utilize the registration portal provided in the email confirmation. Log back in by clicking on the "Already Registered" link from the banner. Enter the confirmation number and email ID. Click on the "Modify" button, and then add sessions via the registration process.

If sessions are full, a waitlist will be created. To be added to a waitlist, log in to the email confirmation, find the session of choice, and select "Join Waitlist." Attendees can only be added to a waitlist from the registration page.

# Education Excellence Fund (EEF) 6/30 Periodic Expense Report (PER) Submissions Please share with business managers, EEF coordinators, school leaders, and superintendents.

The eGMS system is open to begin submitting EEF 6/30 PERs. Schools or agencies that received a payment from the 2024-2025 Education Excellence Fund (EEF) this year are advised of the following important dates:

- May 30: Final Date for EEF Amendments
- June 30: Deadline for EEF Recipients to Obligate EEF Funds
- July 15: Deadline for EEF Recipients to Submit Final 6/30 PERs

The Final PERs are used to calculate EEF allocations for the following year. If the Final PER is not submitted by July 15, EEF recipients may experience delays in accessing their EEF funds for 2025-2026.

When finalizing the PER, navigate to the first tab, "Expenditure Obligation Summary," and locate the "Final Expenditure" checkbox at the bottom. Ensure this box is checked. Failing to do so will prevent the PER from being reported as final, necessitating corrections and resubmission.

# **Assessments, Accountability, and Analytics**

#### **DRC Student Corrections Online Clean Up**

Please share with school leaders and testing coordinators.

DRC INSIGHT will open for student corrections on June 3-6. This process will provide schools and systems with the second of three opportunities to apply documented accountability codes for students who did not participate in the spring administration of LEAP 2025.

This correction process will be limited to application of codes for impending zeros and limited demographic corrections. The LDOE will host a training for district test coordinators via the previously provided link.

There will be no possibility of extending this opportunity. In August, school systems will have their third and final opportunity to request application of accountability codes, as well as requests for some other fields used in accountability, during assessment data certification hosted in La Data Review.

# **K-3 Literacy Summer Screening**
