The LDOE conducts annual monitoring of school systems to ensure compliance with federal and state requirements. To assist school systems in thoughtful planning and preparation for a scheduled monitoring event, the LDOE is releasing the <u>fourth-quarter monitoring schedule</u>*. This schedule is tentative, and the agency reserves the right to make adjustments as necessary.

The assigned Statewide Monitoring Team Leader will send a more detailed monitoring notification reminder, along with any necessary planning documents or instructions, directly to superintendents, federal program, and special education supervisors of each school system appearing on the monitoring schedule.

Internship Funding

HB 1 provides funding in the amount of \$1000 for student-centric expenses associated with internships. It can be used to pay student salaries and buy equipment, uniforms, and/or supplies associated with internships based on policy definition.

To request this funding, all items below must be completed by July 1:

- 1. Contact <u>stephanie.marcum@la.gov</u> to indicate your school system will be pursuing these funds. You will receive the Course Choice portal upload template and the attestation letter.
- 2. Students must be loaded in the <u>Course Choice Portal</u> in the LDOE Internship course as a Spring enrollment.
- 3. Email a signed assurance letter to stephanie.marcum@la.gov by July 1.
- 4. The <u>Funding for Internships</u> required documentation must be kept on file with the school system and available for auditing.
