Alternate Assessment Participation Waiver for Public Comment

Under the requirements of the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA), Louisiana must limit the total number of students who are assessed statewide on alternate assessments to 1.0 percent of the total number of students in the state who are required to participate in statewide assessments. The LDOE intends to seek a waiver for the 2024-2025 school year of this federal requirement that would limit the number of students in the state who participate in alternate assessments. The purpose of this notice is to provide the public with an opportunity to comment on the <u>full waiver request</u>.
