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# Message from the Deputy Superintendent

Dear Colleagues,

I hope you enjoyed a restful Thanksgiving break. As we move into the final weeks of the semester, I want to thank you for your steady leadership and the work you do each day on behalf of Louisiana students.

Before the holiday, we released the 2024–2025 <u>School and District Performance Scores</u>. Louisiana recorded its fourth consecutive year of statewide improvement and reached its highest score under the current system. This sustained progress reflects the commitment of our teachers, leaders, students, and families across the state. Thank you for continuing to push for strong instruction and greater outcomes.

This release also marked the final year of the current accountability model, which has often been criticized as outdated, difficult to understand, and misaligned with modern expectations for true career and college readiness. Beginning this school year, we will transition to our revised system — <u>Grow. Achieve. Thrive.</u> The new approach raises expectations, simplifies how performance is measured, and places greater emphasis on whether students graduate prepared for a career, college, or military service.

I appreciate the work many of you have already begun as you review your simulated results and plan for the transition. Our team will keep providing resources, tools, and guidance to support your efforts.

Louisiana's continued progress shows what's possible when we stay focused on what matters most for students - strong academic outcomes. Thank you for your partnership as we set a new bar for educational excellence in our state.

## IQWST Tier I Archiving and Transition Support

The Tier I review for IQWST will be <u>archived</u> on December 31, 2025, in accordance with <u>RS 17:351.1.b.</u> As a result, school systems with labeled schools currently using IQWST will need to adopt alternative Tier I science instructional materials for the 2026-2027 school year.

## **Dyslexia Core Assessment Program Update**

Please share with school leaders, SPED coordinators, counselors, and teachers.

Act 517 established a statewide pathway for identifying and supporting students flagged as "at risk" for dyslexia LDOE is preparing for the launch of an online application portal, which will allow families to apply for up to \$500 in reimbursement for a dyslexia core assessment conducted by an approved vendor. Additional guidance and school communication tools will be shared ahead of the program's January 2026 launch.

### Crisis Prevention Institute

<u>Act 479</u> revised Louisiana's requirements for the use of seclusion and restraint. In alignment with these updates, the LDOE has partnered with the Crisis Prevention Institute (CPI) to ensure districts receive guidance on the safe use of restrictive interventions, including appropriate safety practices throughout any seclusion or physical restraint event.

To support districts without currently certified CPI instructors, CPI is offering de-escalation and Nonviolent Crisis Intervention training. Eligible districts may register two staff members to become Certified Instructors.

#### **High Cost Services Round 2 Application**

## Annual SPP/APR Indicator Monitoring Outreach

Annually, the LDOE is required to analyze special education data and conduct outreach regarding outcomes for particular indicators as part of the IDEA, Part B State Performance Plan (SPP) and report these in the special education annual performance report (APR).

Results will be provided to school systems via APR outreach packets in the data management file transfer portal (DM FTP) the week of December 8. Any school system identified as noncompliant in one or more targeted indicators will be required to submit a plan of correction to the LDOE by January 9.

## 2025-2026 Evaluation Reminders

Round 1 observations for all teachers should now be complete. For new teachers, it is highly recommended that the first observation occur within the first 45 days of the school year or hire date to ensure early coaching and support, and Round 2 observations for new teachers should be completed or well underway.

SLT meetings and goal-setting conferences should also have occurred, with evaluators reviewing and accepting SLTs in LES. Systems are encouraged to continue referencing the <u>LES Timeline</u> for all key tasks, requirements, and upcoming deadlines to ensure timely and accurate evaluation processes.

Data must be submitted via eGMS by January 6.
