## The New Teacher Experience: Professional Learning Modules

The LDOE, in partnership with A+PEL, has developed monthly professional learning modules on topics that are critical for new teacher success. These modules include online asynchronous content followed by an in-person

learning lab where participants practice and apply these concepts. These five modules are designed to build learning throughout the year. Teachers are expected to complete the entire series of Professional Learning Modules.

- Module 2: Standards and Curriculum
- Module 3: Data Literacy
- Module 4: Literacy for 21st-Century Learners
- Module 5: Parent and Community Engagement

This year, we are offering 245 complimentary seats. We are reserving half for the northern location (Monroe) and half for the southern location (Port Allen). Once those seats are exhausted, teachers may still attend but there will be a cost of \$1,272.00 per teacher to complete the series of modules.

Teachers will be asked to receive approval to attend from their school leader. <u>Registration</u> is now open. Once teachers complete the registration, participants will receive details on selected training locations and an invitation to access the online asynchronous modules.

The LDOE is looking forward to our <u>School Support Institutes</u> and <u>System Leader Regional Collaboration</u> learning for 2024-2025. In preparation for our first session in September, SSI CIR Integrated Pathway participants are asked to bring some beginning-of-the-year informal classroom observation data to the session. This data will be utilized during our internalization and practice portions of the learning. ## **SUN Bucks Application Period**

Please share with parents, schools, and system leaders.

The SUN Bucks application period opened on August 19. Most eligible children were automatically enrolled, but some will need to apply. Families can apply online at <a href="mailto:sunbucks.la.gov">sunbucks.la.gov</a>.

Children who should apply during Phase 3 include students at CEP schools who were not automatically eligible in Phase 1 (SNAP recipients), or Phase 2 (Medicaid, FITAP, KCSP & NSLP benefits), children experiencing homelessness, and migrant children.

Children who should already be enrolled include children ages 5-18 (born between August 15, 2005, and July 1, 2018) who received SNAP, income-based Medicaid, FITAP, or KCSP benefits during the 2023-2024 school year and students at NSLP schools who applied and qualified for free or reduced-price meals.

Children who do not attend NSLP/CEP schools are not eligible for SUN Bucks unless they received SNAP, income-based Medicaid, FITAP, or KCSP benefits and they were born between August 15, 2005, and July 1, 2018.

Children who were streamline certified in Phase 1 or Phase 2 were automatically enrolled in SUN Bucks, and many have already received their one-time \$120 benefit. The SUN Bucks program will start issuing EBT cards to eligible NSLP students in late August.

#### **K-3 Literacy Screening**

Please share with school leaders and testing coordinators.

The Louisiana mCLASS system is now open for DIBELS screening of all students in grades K-3. State law requires that this screening be completed in the first 30 days of school. Custom windows have been set based on each school system's calendar. At the end of 30 days, the system will no longer be accessible for screening.

New to 2024-2025 is the ability to enter alternate assessment screening for students who meet criteria directly into the system. All testing coordinators have been provided with the directions for entering the score from LAAR, which is used as the alternate assessment for this screening. Scores for all students in K-3 must be entered into mCLASS. It is not possible to submit scores to the department with a file upload.

Please ensure that the district test coordinator for each school system sends all communications to the LDOE related to K-3 screening. This includes requests for grade changes, permissions, and testing irregularities. We appreciate your cooperation with this protocol.
