#### **Geaux Teach Scholarship Program**

Act 463 of the 2022 Regular Session of the Louisiana Legislature established the Geaux Teach Program, which provides scholarships to students who are enrolled in teacher preparation programs at the state's postsecondary institutions that are approved by the Board of Elementary and Secondary Education (BESE). Funding is also available to students attending certified alternative teacher preparation programs approved by BESE.

Students may receive up to \$5,000 annually to cover the cost of tuition fees, textbooks, and instructional materials required for enrollment.

#### **Math Competencies**

Act 347 of the 2023 Regular Session states that BESE shall revise teacher certification requirements and the requirements of teacher education programs to require instruction on foundational numeracy skills standards for candidates seeking certification to teach students no later than December 31, 2023.

<u>Bulletin 746 §507.B.12</u> Beginning September 1, 2028, an applicant for initial certification must have earned coursework or equivalent contact hours in alignment with the adopted foundational numeracy competencies.

The Louisiana Department of Education (LODE) has partnered with the National Institute for Excellence in Teaching (NIET) to provide a rubric to directly support improvements in classroom instruction in teacher preparation programs which aligns to the new Louisiana Educator's Rubric (LER).

The goal of this partnership is to ensure that the LDOE evaluation system is a structure of professional learning opportunities tied to evaluation used to recruit and retain effective teachers.

#### 2024-2025 Program Approval Fall Cycle

<u>New program applications</u> window opened May 1 for the fall cycle for teacher preparation programs, <u>mentor teacher</u>, <u>content leader</u>, and ECAC. All Notice of Intents are due **June 1**. Applications are reviewed to ensure applicants meet all policy requirements to obtain approval.

#### TEACHER PREPARATION QUALITY RATING SYSTEM

#### **On-Site Review Updates**

The Teacher Preparation Quality Rating System (TPQRS) includes Preparation Program Experience as one of the domains. An on-site review by a third party is conducted to understand the program's quality once at least every four years. The RFP for the on-site review vendor has been selected and approved. On-site reviews are scheduled to begin late fall. Providers who have been selected for an on-site review

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this fall will be notified.

Each provider received their on-site review timeframe during the performance profile debriefing calls. If your assigned on-site review interferes with any other accreditation timeframe, please email <a href="mailto:believeandprepare@la.gov">believeandprepare@la.gov</a> to request a change.

#### CERTIFICATION

#### **Document Alteration**

The LDOE has recently seen an increase in the submission of altered documents. Documents submitted are legal documents and submitted as evidence for certification. Sections of documents or applications that are already signed by the educator should not be altered in any way after signatures are obtained. Documents that clearly indicate an alteration after a signature **will not** be accepted.

Examples of this include but are not limited to: changing the date on the educator's professional conduct form, filling out the professional conduct form for the educator, altering the out-of-state attestation form, etc.

#### Office Hours Protocol

The Certification Team offers <u>office hours</u> each week for human resource offices and program providers. Office hours are held Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays from 9 a.m. to 10 a.m. and from 3 p.m. to 4 p.m. in 15-minute increments. This service is offered to **HR office personnel and program providers only. Individuals** with questions should submit them through the online portal.

Office hours are staffed by a Senior Specialist and a novice Specialist. As of **April 1**, **2024** the following has been implemented for office hours:

- Submission of an office hours question is required. This office hours question is the mechanism through which our staff responds in writing to summarize the discussion held during office hours. The corresponding office hours question should be submitted prior to even scheduling the appointment; however, if an office hours question is not submitted to coincide with the appointment at least 24 hours prior to the scheduled call, the office hours appointment will be canceled.
- If application processing time is 15 days or less, justification for expediting is required at the time of reservation for consideration. This means the certification office must have the justification at least 24 hours in advance of the call for expediting to be considered.
- Expediting requests may be denied and are at the discretion of the LDOE.

We ask that the following steps be followed to schedule an office hours call:

- Login to HR account in online teacher certification portal, TeachLA Live!
- Use the "Ask a Question" feature along the top ribbon of the page

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- Choose "HR/Prep Provider Office Hours" in the drop-down menu
- Indicate certification questions, cases, candidates, and details around certification questions
- Submit the guestion case and receive case #
- Use online scheduler and indicate the "office hours" question case number in the reservation

#### **Certification Reminders**

**New Applications.** In response to the newly adopted policy coming off of Notice of Intent around May 20, **all applications** will be updated. The expected timeline for all applications to be updated is **June 1, 2024**. Some applications will be posted prior to this date with a June 1 revision date.

Beginning July 1, 2024, all applications are required to be the June 1, 2024 version for processing.

**Foreign Equivalency Transcripts.** New foreign equivalency transcript requirements include that a credentialing agency must be an endorsed member in good standing with either:

- National Association of Credential Evaluation Services (NACES)
- Association of International Credential Evaluators (AICE).

The adopted policy is effective May 20. Updated information is available on teachlouisiana.net.

#### **Certification Monthly Call**

The Certification Office conducts a monthly call devoted solely to certification. Participants for this call should include individuals responsible for the implementation of certification policy in teacher preparation programs and school systems. Topics include legislative and policy updates, certification processing updates, and frequently asked questions. It will generally fall on the third **Monday** of each month at **10:30** a.m. Any changes due to BESE meetings or holidays will be included on the school system support calendar. The next call is **Monday**, **May 20**.
