Starting with graduates of the 2024-2025 school year, FAFSA is not a graduation requirement, but school systems are still obligated to assist those students who desire to complete the application.

**Cohort Graduation Data Certification**

LA Data Review will open in April for accountability contacts to retrieve the 2024 cohort graduation rosters. This information should be distributed to schools, and requests for changes to data that will be used for the calculation of graduation rates and related graduation indices used in the 2024 SPS.

The LDOE will continue to conduct exit code reviews for students.

#### **Elimination of Cohort Graduation Lag Year**

Please share with administrators, counselors, and testing coordinators.

The 2024 SPS will include data from both the 2024 and 2025 cohorts to eliminate the lag year for reporting graduation data.

Beginning with the 2025 graduation cohort, data certification will be divided into two phases. The first phase will continue being conducted during the spring and will include exit code audits only for students who have exited as transferring out of state, to approved nonpublic schools, and to BESE-approved home study. The second phase will be conducted during the summer and will include reviews of LEA and site flags, AP, IB, CLEP data, and HiSET attainment.

Requests to update IBCs and DE course codes are no longer reviewed or approved.

The College Board is awarding <u>AP Participant Grants</u> to qualifying AP teachers to attend an AP Summer Institute (APSI). The participant grant covers the cost of tuition for College Board-endorsed APSI within the United States. The grants are distributed by individual APSI host institutions. The deadline for submissions is **May 31**.

To qualify for the <u>AP Participant Grant</u>, you must:

- Teach an AP course in the upcoming school year;
- Not have attended an APSI or received an APSI scholarship in the past 3 years in the same AP subject;
- Not received professional learning funding from your state, district, or school;
- Teach at a school in the United States.

### **Q & A With COunselor COnnect!**

**Q:** What is a "Community Service Diploma Endorsement," and what are some of the endorsement categories?

**A:** School systems may award a Community Service Endorsement to students completing a minimum of 80 hours of service anytime between ninth and twelfth grades. Students may earn service hours identified in several areas, such as Community, Crisis Support, and Disaster Relief. A list of <a href="Community Service Diploma Endorsement Categories">Community Service Diploma Endorsement Categories</a> and examples of each category can be found on the LDOE website.

Documentation of community service is housed at the local high school. Every year, LDOE and BESE recognize the top three school systems that award the Community Service Diploma Seal by recognizing them at a BESE meeting.

## **Scholarships/Funding Opportunities**

Scholarship awards can range significantly, from modest amounts like \$50-\$500 from local organizations to substantial sums from larger institutions, even covering full tuition. Smaller scholarships can be a great way to secure funding and often have fewer applicants.
