Mentor and Resident Funding

In the 2024-2025 academic year, the data collection for Mentor compensation will take place using a similar process to what was used in 2023-2024. Those unable to join the Fall 2024 Mentor and Resident funding call to review the funding eligibility and process should review the <u>presentation</u>.

School systems were asked to submit all required data no later than October 22 in EdLink. The data snapshot was collected on October 25. Preparation providers should have checked in with school system partners to make sure they have all data submitted in Edlink. Preparation providers should ensure that school systems know which residents/practitioners are teaching in their classrooms. As a reminder, all certificates required (practitioner license, resident license, Mentor credential or waiver) must have been issued by **October 1** in order to be eligible for funding.

Geaux Teach Scholarship Program

Act 463 of the 2022 Regular Session of the Louisiana Legislature established the <u>Geaux Teach</u> <u>Program</u>, which provides scholarships to students who are enrolled in teacher preparation programs at the state's postsecondary institutions that are approved by the Board of Elementary and Secondary Education (BESE). Funding is also available to students attending certified alternative teacher preparation programs approved by BESE.

Students may receive up to \$5,000 annually to cover the cost of tuition fees, textbooks, and instructional materials required for enrollment. Billing dates for the fall semester/term is November 1, the spring semester/term is May 1, and the summer semester/term is July 1 when applicable.

TEACHER PREPARATION PROGRAM APPROVAL

2024-2025 Program Approval Spring Cycle

The <u>new program application</u> window opened on September 1 for the spring cycle for<u>teacher</u> <u>preparation programs</u>, <u>mentor teacher</u>, <u>content leader</u>, and <u>ECAC</u>. All Notice of Intents (NOIs) were due by October 1. All applications that submitted a notice of intent have been reviewed and moved to the full application stage. Full applications for all new programs are due **December 10**.

TEACHER PREPARATION QUALITY RATING SYSTEM

On-Site Review Updates

The Teacher Preparation Quality Rating System (TPQRS) includes the Preparation Program Experience as one of the domains. An on-site review by a third party is conducted to understand the program's quality once at least every four years. Etio, formerly Class Measures, is the external vendor who will be conducting all on-site reviews with our teacher preparation providers.

Providers who are scheduled for the spring on-site review cycle were notified during their TPQRS debrief session. A follow-up email was sent to providers with instructions on how to sign up for the preferred week to conduct reviews via the Teacher Preparation Provider (TPP) online support portal <u>PickTime</u>.

If the assigned on-site review interferes with any other accreditation timeframe, please email <u>believeandprepare@la.gov</u> to request a change. This request must be on official letterhead, signed by the dean or director.

CERTIFICATION UPDATES

October BESE Policy updates

These changes went to BESE in October for adoption and are currently out for Notice of Intent (NOI). The expected date this policy is effective (off of NOI), unless an effective date is otherwise specified, is January 20, 2025.

- Computer Science-micro credentials:
 - Adding secondary computer science grades 6-12
 - Adding computer science and STEM grades K-5
- Updates to Montessori Certification
- Removing the ratings **highly effective** and **effective proficient** in TEP and aligning renewal with the standards of effectiveness in accordance with Bulletin 130
- Out-of-State Principal and Out-of-State Superintendent updates
- Removing teacher competencies and moving to a separate bulletin



Certification Reminders

Phase 1 of New System

The Teacher Certification Online portal, question, and application system will be implemented in phases. Phase 1 includes updating our question submission system. Implementation occurred on Tuesday, October 22, 2024, after business hours.

Users will need:

- <u>MyLa account</u>
- EdLink Security access (HR/Prep user roles only)
- Access to the Teacher Certification ZenDesk Help Center

End users will only need a MyLa account (instructions are linked above). Human Resource and Preparation Providers need the EdLink Security role, although current users have been 'batch uploaded' to the new system. Since the system is live, users will need to 'test' their accounts to ensure appropriate access has been granted. Any user using a generic email address to log-in will be provided temporary access to the HR/Preparation level of access. Additional instructions will be provided after initial live testing to any user with a generic email address on the necessary steps and timeline for requesting a new access/account.

Educator Background Credentialing

Credential Clearance with a Criminal Background Check (CBC) for Certification

Effective **January 1, 2025,** Louisiana law (<u>R.S. 17:8.9</u>) requires criminal background checks (CBCs) for **credentialing**. This law is much more comprehensive than what has historically been in place where the CBC was requested and required for employment (<u>R.S. 17:15</u>).

- A CBC will be required **before** a credential can be issued if LDOE does not have one on file less than five years old.
- If a person has already been issued a credential prior to the implementation of this new law,

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and the LDOE **does not have a cleared CBC** for that person, the credentialed individual will be required to complete the CBC process at the time of applying for renewal, advancement, or modification.

Certification applications **submitted before January 1, 2025**, will be processed without sending the applicant to be fingerprinted.

For applications **submitted on and after January 1, 2025**, the applicant will check www.teachlouisiana.net for a CBC on file with LDOE under five years old. If none exist in the applicant's LDOE file or if the applicant has no certification file, the applicant will be directed to the Credential Clearance (CC) application packet, where the individual will schedule fingerprinting with IdentoGO BEFORE certification can be processed. Certification applications are being updated with a new Professional Conduct form, the link to the Credential Clearance (CC) application packet, and other documents addressing certification clearance and how to determine if one exists or if the applicant will be subject to a new background check for certification.

LDOE may obtain a CBC as needed for credentialing purposes. This allowance in law and policy provides LDOE the discretion to require an updated background check in situations such as:

- The LDOE has been made aware (self-reported, stakeholder reported, news/media outlet, etc.) of recent criminal activity
- An applicant has come from out-of-state or has relocated, requesting Louisiana certification

IdentoGO by Idemia

IdentoGO by IDEMIA provides a wide range of identity-related services with the primary service being the secure capture and transmission of electronic fingerprints for employment, certification, licensing, and other verification purposes. They will fingerprint applicants for Louisiana certification.

IdentoGO has assigned LDOE a specific agency "service code," which will be released with a waiver agreement and all disclosures when an applicant is directed to the CBC process after submitting the Credential Clearance (CC) application packet.

Fingerprint results are returned to the LDOE through the Louisiana Applicant Processing System (LAPS) with the CBC being transmitted within a few hours if the fingerprints are clear.

Actions and Sanctions

Certification may be denied, suspended, or revoked for:

- Conviction of or nolo contendere plea to **any felony** even if dismissed per Article 893/894, expunged, or granted first offender pardon.
- Conviction of or nolo contendere plea to a crime listed in **LA R.S. 15:587.1(C)** even if



dismissed per Article 893/894, expunged, or granted first offender pardon.

- Submitting fraudulent certification documentation to BESE or LDOE.
- Facilitating cheating on any state assessment.
- Censure of another professional credential or license.

Reinstatement via a records review may be considered by BESE based on appeal law and policy that is outlined in Chapter 19 of <u>Bulletin 746</u>.

Background Credentialing Partnership

The new law requires a shared responsibility.

- **BESE** establishes policies for checks, including obtaining fingerprints and requesting information from state and federal bureaus.
- **LDOE** reviews the contents of the CBC before processing certification, making public any certification denial, suspension, and revocation.
- **PREPARATION PROVIDERS** assist teacher candidates in applying for the pre-service certificates informing them of the CBC requirement.
- **EMPLOYING SCHOOL SYSTEMS** notify LDOE upon the termination, resignation, or resignation in lieu of termination of any certified employee within 10 days of separation of service when the action results from conviction for any felony or any offenses listed in R.S. 15:587.1
- **CERTIFIED INDIVIDUALS** required to report criminal convictions to LDOE within two business days.
