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LEADS Corner

The <u>Guide for School Leaders: Planning for Implementation</u> is an available resource to support LEADS implementation. Below are a few steps to continue your smooth transition to LEADS.

- School leaders develop a long-range plan for teacher collaboration professional learning opportunities, where educators/teachers build LER depth of knowledge and self-assessment skills. This plan should align with the instructional leadership team's learning (extended LER indicator deep dives, connections to HQIM implementation, connections to student work).
- School instructional leadership teams conduct trend analysis with observation data from the first cycle of
 educator observations, identify strengths and growth opportunities, and determine next steps for the team's
 professional learning.
- For eligible educators, designated observers/evaluators of educators at each school conduct the second cycle of observations and the subsequent follow-up coaching and support cycle.

LEADS Implementation Support

Principals are encouraged to participate in LEADS implementation support opportunities. The January and February <u>LEADS Implementation On-Site Support Sessions</u> focus on the observation and post-conference process. Participants will engage in the observation process in real-time in Louisiana classrooms. Following the observation, participants will plan a post-observation conference. Registration is now open in <u>EventBrite</u>.

<u>LEADS Implementation Monthly Webinars</u> provide an additional opportunity to deepen understanding of the evaluation components and processes.

2023-2024 Evaluation Close-Out in CIS

All 2023-2024 evaluation data for teachers, counselors, and other instructional staff should be <u>finalized</u> in <u>CIS</u> at this time. The deadline to enter or edit leader evaluations is January 31. Prior to the deadline, principals should review rosters to ensure all data is accurate. Data cannot be entered or edited in CIS following this date.

As a reminder, all 2024-2025 evaluation data should be entered directly into LES for all schools, regardless of the chosen evaluation type; there will be no transfer of scores or spreadsheet uploads in the new system.

Louisiana Evaluation System (LES)

LES has replaced the Compass Information System (CIS), and all 2024-2025 evaluation data should be entered into LES. Even if a system is using a legacy evaluation (COMPASS or approved alternate rubric), data is reported in LES. Earlier this month, LES webinars were held for school leaders.
