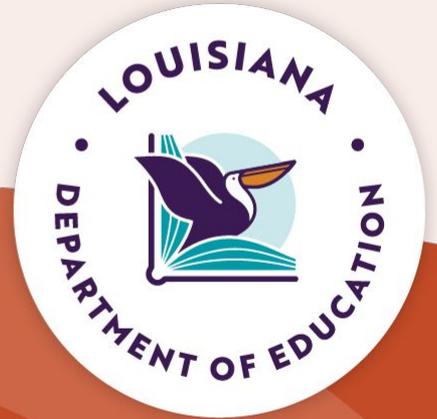
TLS 2026 will feature almost 400 impactful and engaging sessions focused on:

Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) Compliance



ADA Title II: Compliance Deadlines

- In April 2024, the U.S. Department of Justice (DOJ) finalized a new rule under [ADA Title II](#).
- All public school systems fall under this rule and must ensure web content and mobile apps meet [Web Content Accessibility Guidelines \(WCAG\) 2.1, Level AA standards](#).
- Deadlines are based on the parish population where the school system is located based on the 2020 census.
 - **April 24, 2026:** Deadline for Large Systems (Population > 50,000)
 - **April 26, 2027:** Deadline for Small Systems (Population < 50,000)

Scope

- This [rule](#) applies to all school system's services, programs, and activities delivered online. This includes:
 - all websites (public-facing and internal, including password-protected portals).
 - mobile apps.
 - digital documents (e.g., PDFs, Word docs, slide decks, spreadsheets).
 - educational content and course materials.
 - new social media posts.
 - third-party tools you provide or make available to the public (e.g., online payment portals, scheduling tools, or learning platforms).

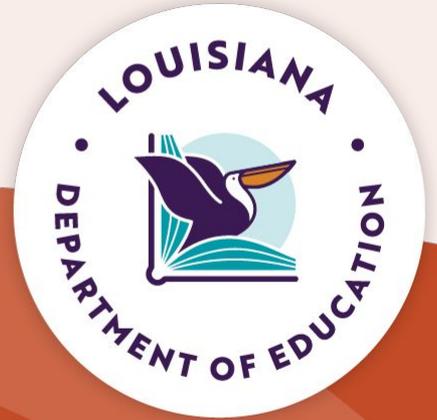

Do's and Don'ts of AI Integration



DO's

- ✓ Keep the focus on the curriculum tasks and activities
- ✓ Keep the integrity of the embedded assessments and sequence of the curriculum
- ✓ Be intentional with tech use



DON'Ts

- ✗ Use technology to replace writing
- ✗ Change the HQIM prompts to fit the tech
- ✗ Just use technology to use it

Before implementing any AI tool, verify that it is approved by your school system.

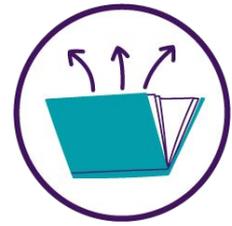
C.R.E.A.T.E. Framework

C	Character: Define the persona or role the AI should play.
R	Request: State the specific task or instruction clearly.
E	Examples: Provide examples of the desired output if you have them. This helps the AI understand the format, style, and level of detail you're looking for.
A	Additions: Add context, tone, or point of view.
T	Type of Output: Specify the desired format and length of the response.
E	Extras: Include any further information that might be helpful, such as reference text or specific constraints.

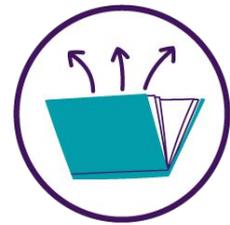


Canva AI in Science Instruction



- **The Challenge:** Students struggle to visualize phenomena.
- **Strategy:** The Slow Reveal & Virtual Field
- **The Toolbox:**
 - Canva AI: Gen AI feature will create interactive activities with a prompt.
 - *Prompt: Create something interactive that grade 7 students could use to study coastal erosion*
 - Output

Canva AI in Science Instruction



- **Improved Prompt:** "You are an experienced middle school science teacher who specializes in environmental science and hands-on learning. I want you to create a simulation that Grade 7 students can use to understand the causes and effects of coastal erosion in Louisiana. For example, this could be a 'choose your own adventure' activity where students make decisions to protect a shoreline, or a virtual lab experiment. Use an engaging, inquisitive tone that encourages scientific inquiry and focus on real-world phenomena like the disappearing Gulf Coast wetlands. Include clear instructions for students to follow. The activity should be designed for a 30-minute session and accommodate varying reading levels."
