

Attendance Works Options for Louisiana Schools:

Attendance Works promotes equal opportunities to learn and advances student success by reducing chronic absence. Founded in 2010, we have a strong track record of successful partnerships which get results. We have found that chronic absence can be significantly reduced when schools, families and community partners work together to monitor data, promote good attendance and address the hurdles that keep children from getting to school every day. We provide the following professional development opportunities for school teams:

1. National Attendance Awareness Campaign webinars – Free of charge

The campaign urges schools, localities and states to promote the value of good attendance and to take concrete steps towards reducing chronic absence. It includes the designation of September (or the start of school) as Attendance Awareness Month and the launch of yearlong attendance campaigns. Participants will be introduced to districts and schools that have improved attendance by implementing best practices. - 2. Professional E-Learning Series for School Teams \$300 per person Twice a year, Attendance Works offers a three-part e-training for educators to learn proven, evidence-based, tiered strategies to promote attendance and engagement using a team approach. Participants learn how to use attendance data to identify students who are chronically absent, understand root causes of absenteeism and create a school-wide plan to improve attendance. - 3. **Tailored E-Learning Series for Districts** \$9,000 (\$300 per person with a minimum of 30) Attendance Works can adapt the professional e-learning series for districts to fit their schedule. We recommend a minimum of two weeks between sessions.
