

Emergency Assistance for Non-Public Schools (EANS) Program Program Information

The Emergency Assistance for Non-Public School (EANS) Fund is a \$55 million grant that was allotted to Louisiana through the Federal Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2021 (CRRSA) signed into law on December 27, 2020.

Key Takeaways

- Funds are reserved through the Governor's Emergency Education Relief Fund (GEERII)
- CRRSA allotted \$2.75 billion nationally for the EANS Program
- Louisiana was allotted \$55 million of the EANS Program funds

Eligibility Requirements

- Non-public/non-profit elementary and secondary school as defined in section 8101 of the ESEA of 1965
- Accredited, licensed, or otherwise operates in accordance with State law
- In existence prior to March 13, 2020, the date the President declared the national emergency due to COVID-19
- Did not, and will not, apply for and receive a loan under the Small Business Administration's Paycheck Protection Program (PPP) (15 U.S.C. 636(a) (36)-(37)) on or after December 27, 2020

Personal Paycheck Protection (PPP) Clarification
