

# 2025-2026 Super App Launch FAQ

#### Q. How do I download and share the interactive Workbook?

**A.** The Workbook is view only. Users can copy it to a Google account (File > Make a Copy) and set appropriate user permissions.

### Q: Will Literacy Coach salaries be an allowable expense for CLSD?

**A:** While the official position of "literacy coach" is no longer an option in the new CLSD application, literacy mentor salaries will be an option for funding.

# Q: Will a job description be made available for the literacy mentors under the new CLSD application?

**A:** Yes, the teaching and learning team will provide a description soon.

### Q: Will there be a rubric for the CSI/TSI plans?

**A:** Yes, a rubric will be made available soon. More info will be provided on the November FSGR monthly call.

## Q: Can you provide a link to the most updated list of schools with CIR/UIR labels?

**A:** A list of updated CIR/UIR-A labeled sites will be posted to LDOE's website in November. Once available, we will include the list in the workbook for you.

# Q: For allowable curricula purchases for CIR/UIR-A schools, should funds only be requested for new implementation of a Tier I curriculum, or can funds be requested for continued implementation of needed materials? (e.g., Amplify consumable workbooks)?

**A:** Allowable curricula purchases may be used for new and continuing implementation. The only curricula that can be purchased using Redesign funds in 2025-2026 are Algebra I, Geometry, Algebra II, K-8 social studies, Civics, K-8 science, and Biology.

## Q: Can we utilize our Redesign funds for item(s) not identified as eligible expenses?

**A:** Please review the items on the eligible expenditures tab of the workbook. Only those items listed are eligible for Redesign funding. If there's a unique need, consider submitting the <u>Alternate Evidence-Based Option</u> form for approval.

#### Q. Where can I find a link for the most up-to-date list of CIR/UIR-A schools?

**A.** A list of updated CIR/UIR-A labeled sites will be posted to the LDOE's website in November. Once available, we will add the list to the Workbook.

#### Q. Will CLSD funds go through Super App?

**A.** Yes. Districts will be notified via email outside of eGMS of their approval status, but the budgeting process will be a part of the Super App.

- Q. What is considered a high number of third graders at risk of retention?
- **A.** At least 50% is considered at risk.
