

Louisiana School Finder: Data Guide

Purpose of the Guide

This document was created to provide a description and source of the data that will be publicly available in the new Louisiana School Finder. The school and district pages are organized into seven major reporting categories. The data provided are suppressed to protect the identification of students in small groups or for reporting certain performance data below 5% or above 95%.

Requests for Changes or Additional Information

"About our School" pages are refreshed monthly. Some reported data are final and cannot be changed. Information about how to make changes and who to contact with questions is provided for each category.

Reporting Categories

Overall Information about the School: Address, contact information, grades served, district, principal name(s), school type, course offerings, clubs and sports.

Overall Performance Data: School and school system performance score (SPS) data. Includes comprehensive intervention, top gains, and equity honoree status (new in 2018), where applicable. New in 2018: Compares results under the new and old accountability formulae; displays letter grade equivalents for key indices under student performance (state assessments, ACT, graduation rate, strength of diploma) and student progress.

Student Performance Data: State assessment results, 9th grade credit accumulation, ACT, graduation, credentials, and college enrollment data. New in 2018: FAFSA submission.

Breakdown by Student Groups: School performance and enrollment percentages by race/ethnicity, economically disadvantaged, students with disabilities, English learners, military affiliated (new in 2018), homeless (new in 2018), and foster (new in 2018). Includes intervention labels, where applicable.

Teacher Workforce: Teacher certification and retention data, and teacher demographics. New in 2018: teacher attendance rates.


Discipline and Attendance: Out-of-school suspension rates and chronic absenteeism (students missing 15 or more days of school). Includes intervention labels for discipline, where applicable.

Early Childhood Programs: License type, hours of operation, transportation, inspection visit information, offers pre-K scholarship, accepts CCAP, early education capacity, star rating, performance profile.




