Mentor Waiver Process

Guide to the new portal process for Mentor Waivers and Alternate Mentor Waivers

Beginning in September 2020, every teacher who serves as the mentor of an undergraduate or post-baccalaureate candidate must hold the Mentor Certificate or the Provisional Mentor Ancillary Certificate.

Prompted by a shortage of credentialed Mentor Teachers willing to host residents specifically in certain content areas, BESE has allowed a waiver of the Mentor Credential since the 2020-2021 school year

The following is guidance to support system leads, mentors, principals and in the case of the Alternate Mentor waiver, education preparation providers, with how to properly complete the online application.
