CONSENT ORDER

This matter was set for hearing November 17, 2011 on the State's request for a preliminary injunction to halt the operation of an unlicensed child day care facility. Prior to hearing, the parties reached an agreement and enter into this Consent Order on the following terms:

- Defendant, Francine Chouset consent to the issuance of a preliminary injunction prohibiting her from operating a child day care facility without a license;
- In recognition of Francine Chouset cooperation, the State waives its request for statutory fines and penalties so long as Francine Chouset complies with this order;
- Francine Chouset does agree to allow the Louisiana Department of Children and Family Services access to the facility as necessary to conduct site visits in compliance with state and federal guidelines.

The Court being satisfied that the Consent Order is reasonable under the circumstances, considering the verified petition and supporting affidavits, and is in accordance with law and evidence in this case, therefore

IT IS ORDERED that a preliminary injunction issue, directed to defendant Francine Chouset, and enjoining, restraining and prohibiting her, her officers, directors, agents, employees, representatives, and all others acting on her behalf, from operating a child day care facility without a license; this preliminary injunction to be effective during the pendency of these proceedings;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the State hereby waives the statutory

fines and penalties sought in its petition, contingent upon Defendant's compliance with this Order;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Francine Chouset do consistent with this Order,
allowing the Louisiana Department of Children and Family Services access to the
facility as necessary to conduct site visits in compliance with state and federal
guidelines.
