ORDER

This matter came on for hearing the twentieth day of July, 2009 on the Department of Social Services' request for a preliminary injunction to block the operation of an unlicensed child day care facility. The parties stipulated that defendants have applied for a child day care license; that they are currently providing care and supervision to more than six children unrelated to the caregiver outside the presence of their parents; that defendants assert that their present operation is a summer camp exempt from licensure; that the Department considers the present operation an extension of defendants' school-year child day care services which requires licensure; that defendants summer camp will end on August 5, 2009 and defendants desire that their facility be inspected for licensing purposes on August 6, 2009; and that DSS written policy, but not its current regulations, requires that a facility be closed prior to conducting an initial child care licensing inspection; therefore


IT IS ORDERED that defendants Michelle Lavergne and Leaps and Bounds Sports Center, L.L.C., close on August 6, 2009;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Department of Social Services, Division of Child Care and Early Childhood Development, Child Care Licensing and Regulatory Section, conduct a licensing inspection of defendants' facility on August 6, 2009 to determine whether it meets the requirements for licensure;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the preliminary injunction issue as requested, in form and substance like the temporary restraining order previously issued by this Court, directed to defendants MICHELLE LAVERGNE and LEAPS AND BOUNDS SPORTS CENTER, L.L.C.,


enjoining, restraining and prohibiting them, together with their agents, employees, representatives, and all other persons acting at their direction or on their behalf, from operating a child day care facility without first having obtained a license for same from the Louisiana Department of Social Services; the preliminary injunction to go into effect at 12:01 a.m. August 10, 2009 and remain effective during the pendency of these proceedings.
