Eligibility

Who is Eligible for a Scholarship?

Applicants must:

- Be a resident of Louisiana, and
- Have a family household income that does not exceed 250% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines (<u>See this table here</u>), and
- Be entering kindergarten for the first time OR currently attending a C, D, or F public school on both October 1 and February 1 of this current year.
- ** All new applicants must provide proof of income and residency eligibility in order to complete the Scholarship Application Process **

LSP Site Registration for 2024-2025

Award Notifications

- Families will be notified of awards on April 29 via email.
- Letters will also be sent to parents via mail.
- If offered an award, families will need to complete site registration beginning on April 29.
 - Site Registration will end on May 24.
 - All families must accept their award no later than May 24.
- If a family does not complete site registration by **May 24**, they may lose the awarded scholarship.



Site Registration

Schools are responsible for the following actions as part of the registration process:

- Maintaining updated income and residency eligibility documentation for each student
- Collecting required registration forms from all scholarship families
 - Parent waiver for special education services
 - Parent acknowledgements regarding Scholarship funds
 - Receipt of rules and regulations form
- Sharing the school handbook with families
- Informing families of all school rules, regulations and policies, and <u>have</u> each family participating in the scholarship program sign an acknowledgement of receipt of these rules.

Transfer Request

Scholarship students who wish to transfer to another participating school must accept the scholarship at the original awarded school.

- The transfer window for the 2024-2025 school will open on **June 10**.
- Families are required to submit a Transfer Request form to the Department signed by both the parent/guardian and a representative of the receiving school.
- If a student transfers without a completed transfer form and email approval from the Department, they may lose their Scholarship.
 - It is the school's responsibility to inform the family when the transfer has been approved.
- The transfer window for the 2024-2025 school year will temporarily close on July 22.



Decline Awards

Once a family declines the award, they will no longer be eligible to receive a scholarship for the remainder of the 2024-2025 school year.

- This is NOT for families wishing to transfer to another scholarship school for the 2024-2025 school year.
- Once the award has been declined, it cannot be reinstated.
- If a family declines an award, they must re-apply in the fall in order to be eligible for any scholarships awarded in upcoming years.
- The family must sign the decline award form at the awarding school.
- By completing the form, you understand that you are <u>willingly choosing</u> to not participate in the LSP program for the 2024-2025 school year.
- Declined awards must be submitted no later than May 24.





Important Reminders

Site Registration for the 2024-2025 school year begins on **April 29**.

- Award notifications will go out to families via letter and email on April 29.
 - Families must provide updated income and residency eligibility documentation for each student when registering at the school.
 - The address on the documentation provided must match the address listed on the application.
- Families must accept or decline their award no later than May 24.
 - If a family does not complete site registration by May 24, they may lose the awarded scholarship.
- Site Registration ends on May 24.

Quarter 4 reporting for the Louisiana Scholarship Program (SEE) and School Choice Program (SCS) is from May 1-6.

- If the enrollment reports are not submitted on time, it affects student enrollment counts and delays payments.
- All Quarterly Enrollment Reports must be submitted on time via the LEADS portal to receive payments on-time.
- If a student drops from your school, follow the drop procedures so that the student can be dropped from your roster.



- If you would like to transfer to another scholarship school:
 - The summer transfer window is open June 10 July 19.
 - You must accept your scholarship at the awarded school before requesting a transfer.
 - Your transfer is not complete until the school receives notification from our office.
 - It is the school's responsibility to inform the family when the transfer has been approved.
- If you wish to decline your award:
 - You must complete the declined award form at the awarding school by May 24.
 - This is NOT for families wishing to transfer to another scholarship school for the 2024-2025 school year.
