### **Funding Prioritization**



#### PHASE 1:

- 1. Participated in the Louisiana Scholarship Program (LSP) previous school year
- Families with a total income at or below 250% of the federal poverty guidelines OR students identified as having a disability under IDEA
- Siblings of Louisiana Scholarship Program (LSP) OR students identified as having a disability under IDEA
- 4. Students entering kindergarten OR students who were enrolled in a public school the previous school year

#### PHASE 2:

Families with a total between 251% and income at or below 400% of the federal poverty guidelines

#### PHASE 3:

All remaining Kindergarten to Twelfth Grade students



- The Louisiana Scholarship Program will continue to be administered through the end of the 2024-2025 school year, but will sunset on June 30, 2025.
- The Louisiana Department of Education will contact current Louisiana Scholarship Program families on next steps for the 2025-2026 school year.
- Students who participated in LSP from 2024-2025 shall be awarded an amount equal to the award amount received during the 2024-2025 school year, subject to the allocation of state funds.
- The student shall continue to receive this award until they completes the school's terminal grade or until they leave the school, whichever comes first.
- All Louisiana Scholarship Program students and nonpublic schools will receive priority access to the LA GATOR Scholarship Program.





Applying for enrollment to a LA school is a **separate** process from applying for an ESA through the Odyssey portal. Identifying the school that the student plans to attend in the Odyssey Account has no bearing on whether the student will be admitted to that school. School enrollment is unrelated to the application and selection process, and is strictly between the family and the school.
