



Student Engagement and Success Guidance for Urgent Intervention Required (UIR)-Discipline

THE UIR-DISCIPLINE STRATEGY

Every day, all students are in schools that treat them with dignity and respect and where they have the opportunity to build knowledge of the world, read meaningful texts, express ideas through writing and speaking, and solve complex problems.

Schools that treat students with dignity and respect have:

- A positive school climate where adults build strong relationships with students.
- Explicit social and emotional instruction.
- Structures in place that meets the social and emotional needs of students.

During the 2020-2021 school system planning process, UIR-D schools will choose a leader responsible for coordinating the UIR-Discipline schools. The school system leader will:

- Ensure UIR-D school(s) identify a Student Engagement and Success Leadership Team (i.e. five members - District Administrator, School Administrator, Professional School Counselor, Teacher, and other staff);
- Attend in-person convenings with the UIR-D School Leadership Team(s) for Student Engagement and Success; and
- Support the UIR-D school(s) in implementing the student engagement and success strategy for academic year 2021-2022.
